Position The Teacher of Design Technology (including coding) reports to the Summary: Vice Principal and is expected to teach across Key Stage 2 and some elements in key Stage 1 as well as contribute to the school's cocurricular programme. The specialist DT lessons will be taught in the newly equipped Innovation Centre, as well as our Digi pod Space. The majority of the teaching role for this position will be to develop a pioneering approach in the Innovation Centre, where KS2 classes are being introduced the advanced digital technologies of CAD/CAM, laser cutting, 3D printing, micro controllers etc., albeit through the continuation of the practical, problem solving approach of the subject. Knowledge, interest and experience in the latest developments in CAD/CAM and related technologies are therefore expected. We are seeking an outstanding, experienced practitioner with excellent contemporary design and technology knowledge and skills to further enhance new ways of learning, thinking and working in our students in our newly developing department.
