Staffing

We currently have four full-time female PE teachers (one of whom is the Team Leader and another of whom is an Assistant Headteacher), one part-time female teacher and three full-time male teachers (one of whom is an Assistant Headteacher and the other two of whom are Pastoral Team Leaders).

Main features of the department

The PE department enjoys extensive, fairly new, facilities including a 4 badminton court sports hall, dance studio, Astroturf pitch, gymnasium, two fitness/weights rooms, ample playing fields, two sets of netball/tennis courts, a PE theory classroom and 3 sets of changing rooms.

The team of staff are passionately dedicated to providing good quality PE experiences for all students regardless of ability and experience and are keen to provide opportunities for students to further their sport, both in school extra-curricular clubs and in the wider community.

PE in Years 7, 8 & 9 is taught in mixed ability groups of single gender and students receive 2 x 60 minute lessons per week.

Years 10 & 11 receive 1 x 60 minute core PE lesson per week, while those taking BTEC Sport at KS4 will have an additional 5 x 60 minutes across a fortnight.

At Sixth Form, students taking the Extended Diploma will receive 12 x 60 minute lessons per week, while those taking the Extended Certificate will have 4 x 60 minute lessons.

Main responsibilities of the post

- to assist in the management and maintenance of resources

- to follow departmental procedures
- to communicate and meet with parents when appropriate
- participation in implementing the department's Development Plan
- to be a positive role model
- to be a Tutor if required
- to undertake all other duties associated with being a teacher at The Blue School.
