Summary of The Role:

Alongside the School Cook, the Trainee School Cook will create, prepare or cook appealing, nutritious, and well balanced menu choices to a high standard for all school users, achieving high levels of Food Hygiene and Health & Safety standards at all times.

The Trainee School Cook will support the on-site catering team with the delivery of food service to pupils and staff, supporting the preparation and delivery on a daily basis. The Assistant Chef will also support the maintenance of the kitchen, ensuring hygiene levels are maintained and stock is stored and replenished as required. The Trainee School Cook will have sound knowledge of COSHH and SFBB recording systems.

The Trainee School Cook will assist in the day to day running of the kitchen, across all areas. This will include preparing a range of main dishes hot and cold, cakes, sandwiches and snacks and, on occasion, buffets for coffee mornings and meetings. The Trainee School Cook must demonstrate sufficient experience, competence and professionalism in fresh food preparation; to be able to work unsupervised at times and must have the ability to work independently in the absence of the Trainee School Cook whilst they are working in other sites 1 to 2 days a week.

Food Preparation:

- Proactively contribute towards the design of the full school menu each half term in collaboration with the School Chef
- Prepare, cook and present food ready for service on a daily basis across all areas of the kitchen (hot main meals, salads, side dishes, desserts and sweets)
- Ensure the full school menu and food choices are nutritionally balanced and comply with the 'School Food Standards for Nutrition'
- Ensure food is made from fresh, seasonal ingredients that are locally sourced
- Ensure food options cater for a range of dietary needs and tastes, with 'something for everyone'. Dairy free, gluten free and vegan options
- To monitor food levels during various service periods

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Main Duties and Responsibilities:

Stock Control:

- Monitor food stock and place orders
- Ensure food stock is always adequate for the number of covers that need to be served each day
- To ensure, when necessary, that all products are checked on delivery and stored in the appropriate areas

General:

- To be responsible for a high standard of food provision ensuring food is tasty and looks appealing
- To assist the wider team, as and when requested
- To be a positive contributor within the Catering Team
- Ensure sound knowledge of the Food to be served daily, together with the appropriate garnish, portion sizes and allergen information
- To comply with school policies of quality and standards in a catering environment and as directed by the SFBB
- To be a positive role model within the team and report any discord or frustrations within the team to management to help find a solution
- To assist and advise the School Chef of any needs or requirements
- To support and assist the School Chef in preparing, cooking and delivery of taster foods during school functions
- Maintain Health & Safety and Hygiene standards in line with the current legislation
- Adhere to appropriate customer service on dealing with comments or complaints – ensure that the School Chef is made aware
- Ensure that personal appearance, including uniform and footwear are of the highest possible standard at all times
