Position Summary: The Teacher of Design & Technology (including robotics/coding and 'DEC' Design, Engineer, Construct) reports to the Vice Principal and is expected to teach across Key Stage 2 and some elements in Key Stage 1, as well as contribute to the school's co-curricular programme. The Specialist D&T lessons will be taught in the newly equipped CAD Innovation suite, D&T workshop, Art room and Food Technology kitchen. The department houses a full suite of laptops, a 3D printer, laser cutter, vacuum former, sublimation printer, heat press, sewing machines, a variety of wood working tools and machinery, a full suite of robots and a fully equipped kitchen. The ideal candidate would be able to teach across all areas of Design and Technology and would have the skills to continue developing the advanced digital technologies of robotics and coding, CAD/CAM including laser cutting and 3D printing, as well as the children's designing, practical and problem-solving skills, through delivering exciting and engaging lessons. Therefore knowledge, interest, and experience in the latest developments in CAD/CAM and Design & Technology are expected. As previously mentioned, we also deliver the 'DEC' Design, Engineer, Construct course which focuses on Architecture and Engineering and an ideal candidate would also be willing to continue this provision and deliver 'DEC' awards to the children. We are seeking an outstanding, experienced practitioner with excellent knowledge and skills to further enhance new ways of learning, thinking, and working with our students in our newly developed department.

General:

Shrewsbury International School Bangkok City Campus is a purpose-built primary school in the heart of Bangkok. The campus is designed specifically for children aged 3-11 years old. 672 places are available from Early Years 1 (Age 3+) to Year 6 (Ages 11+).

The school operates on 25,000sqm of learning space. There are 4 major buildings, which house state-of-the-art facilities for Early Years, Primary, Sport and Creative Arts.

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City Campus opened its gates in August 2018. It builds on the success of Shrewsbury International School Bangkok Riverside, where 1,700 students study from ages 3-18.

Both City Campus and Riverside share the same values, ethos and mission. The campuses come together to form Shrewsbury International School Bangkok, and children from City Campus will graduate to Riverside in Year 7 (Age 12+).

The campuses work closely together to create exciting and unique opportunities for both children and for staff.
