

THE PSYCHOLOGY CURRICULUM AREA

The College has undertaken a review and a strategic reorganisation of curriculum areas beginning in Sept 2020. The Psychology curriculum area will form part of the new Division B. The Division is grouped as follows: Accounting, Economics, Business areas, Computing, IT, Languages, Maths, Physics, Politics and Psychology.

There has been growth in Psychology over the last few years. Currently student numbers are 260 in Year 2 and 270 in Year 1. The department is expected to at least maintain this level of intake. The department teaches the AQA specification.

The Psychology team are committed to providing a quality educational experience for all students and actively encourages social inclusion. Many extra-curricular opportunities are provided, such as trips to London and New York, and visits from external speakers.

The team prepares all its own teaching resources and these are regularly reviewed. All resources are designed to be interactive and differentiated with a strong emphasis on assessment for learning.

It is expected that the successful applicant will be able to work well with the other members of this dynamic and supportive team and will make an active contribution to the Division's quality systems and to the continuous improvement in teaching, learning, assessment and student performance management that is central to the Division's shared objectives.

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
