The Science Faculty consists of a Head of Faculty, Deputy Head of Faculty, two Key Stage Coordinators and four other Science teachers. All of the Faculty are fully qualified Science teachers and teach across the full age-range and performance levels, in all disciplines.

We are committed to raising attainment for all of our students. Our vision is for all lessons to be at least good and with this comes high quality feedback and assessment for learning. The department are committed and work as a close knit team, supporting and encouraging improvements and ideas. There is a continual focus on CPD, linked to our priorities and needs, to support good teaching to raise attainment.

The facilities are excellent with 7 dedicated Science laboratories, one with a full suite of computers, and a main preparation room. Each laboratory is well equipped for all aspects of science teaching.



In students are taught in mixed performance groups and at KS4 we offer our more able pupils the chance to study separate sciences. At KS4, students follow the Edexcel combined and separate sciences courses.
