A Level examinations were cancelled this year following the closure of schools in the UK, as part of the response to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Students have nevertheless received GCSE, AS and A level grades as well as grades for the Extended Project Qualification. We submitted to the exam boards our judgement of the grade a student would most likely have received if the exams (and any non-exam assessments) had taken place. The exam boards asked schools and colleges to develop these centre assessment grades (CAGs) in line with Ofqual's published guidance for heads of centre, heads of department, subject leaders and teachers. During the final six weeks of the academic year prior to the regular examination study leave students were taught 100% live lessons online via Microsoft Teams. We followed the same curriculum, content and timetable as we were using when physically in school. The academic calendar also remained untouched. The only change for our final year students was the addition of an online enrichment programme which we provided after the examinations were cancelled.
