Founded in 1978, Dubai College is a British overseas co-educational senior school. We are academically selective and not for profit. Through collaboration with teaching staff, our warm and intellectually curious students become independent and passionate self-motivated learners. We place equal emphasis on academic, creative, sporting and philanthropic development and as a result enjoy growing global recognition for the quality of our creative and sporting output, and for the generosity of our student-led charity work. Dubai College students are amazingly bright, busy and caring individuals.

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A Level examinations were cancelled this year following the closure of schools in the UK, as part of the response to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Students have nevertheless received GCSE, AS and A level grades as well as grades for the Extended Project Qualification. We submitted to the exam boards our judgement of the grade a student would most likely have received if the exams (and any non-exam assessments) had taken place. The exam boards asked schools and colleges to develop these centre assessment grades (CAGs) in line with Ofqual's published guidance for heads of centre, heads of department, subject leaders and teachers. During the final six weeks of the academic year prior to the regular examination study leave students were taught 100% live lessons online via Microsoft Teams. We followed the same curriculum, content and timetable as we were using when physically in school. The academic calendar also remained untouched. The only change for our final year students was the addition of an online enrichment programme which we provided after the examinations were cancelled. These online sessions were universally well received and well attended.

LOCATION

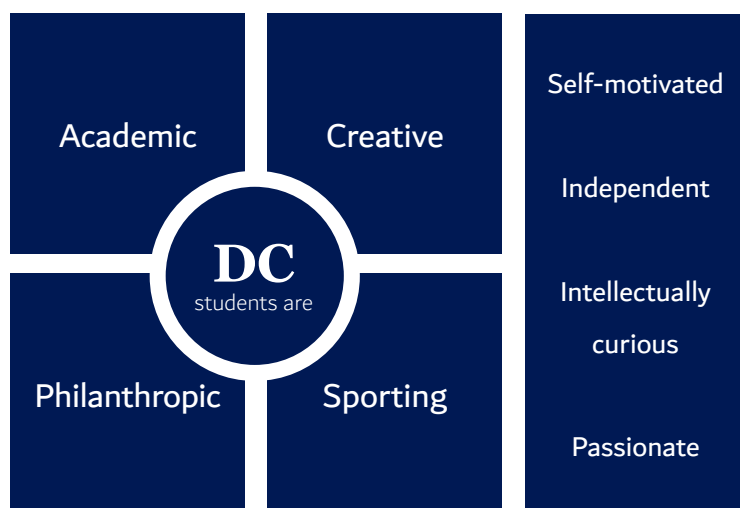
