Position Summary

The Drama teacher will be responsible for developing in each student, an interest in and the ability for creative expression in drama (and movement), using skills and techniques of dramatic expression consistent with school guidelines; to discover and develop talents of students in the field of drama.

Key Responsibilities

Consistent with the current Christian Community Ministries Enterprise Agreement, Livingstone Christian College Policy and the Biblical basis of the College:

- Teach knowledge and skills in drama
- Demonstrate techniques in activities such as drawing and painting
- Knows and can apply elements of drama
- Provide individual and small-group instruction to adapt the curriculum to the needs of students with varying intellectual and artistic abilities, and to accommodate a variety of instructional activities
- Organize storage areas and control use of materials to prevent loss or abuse, and to minimize time required for distribution and collection
- Select and requisition instructional aids
- Maintain professional competence through in-service education activities provided by the school and/or in self-selected professional growth activities
- Communicate with parents and school counsellors on pupil progress
- Participate in curriculum and other developmental programs, such as drama club
- Perform any other duties as may be assigned by Administration
