 - Strong and effective governance
 - Teaching & Learning strategies which are rooted in evidence-based research (eg Lesson Study) and take advantage of informed modern practice (eg Oracy)
 - Sharing of best practice and high quality resources (eg Firefly)
 - Tailored, high-quality CPD and coaching.
