



LOCATION

St Albans stands as a unique English Cathedral City. The city's colourful history can be seen in the Roman remains and beautiful medieval architecture. The city centre has a wonderful mix of shops from small independents, high street stores and a renowned bi-weekly market. We also have a fantastic range of eating and drinking establishments which add to this buzzing metropolis.

St Albans is a highly desirable place to live and work partly due to its commuter links with London (20 minutes by train into London St Pancras), the Abbey Flyer train (10 minutes to Watford Junction), a short hop to the M1 and M25 and within easy reach of London Luton and Heathrow airports.
