Bridlington School offers a rich and varied curriculum for students to provide them with a wealth of opportunities to succeed and fulfil their potential.

Key Stage 3 subjects include: English, Maths, Science, Sport, History, Geography, French and/or Spanish, ICT, Music, Drama, Art, Design Technology, RE and PSHCE.

Key Stage 4 core subjects (English, Maths, Science, Sport, PSHCE and RE) are offered with a range of optional GCSE and BTEC qualifications, including: Art, Digital Media, Drama, Engineering, Food Technology, French, Geography, German, Graphics, History, ICT, Music, Performing Arts, Photography, Product Design, Spanish, Sport and Textiles.
