Regular staff meetings with Rebbes and teachers coupled with weekly מנהלים 's and Lesson Observations by the מנהלים and Headteachers are used to ensure each talmid is maximising his progress

The Academic

Constant curriculum review takes place annually in both Kodesh and Chol, resulting in new subjects, qualifications and lessons allocations to ensure that we're constantly meeting the needs of our talmidim.

Our Chol curriculum is based on a stage not age concept, allowing boys to work ahead of their peers where suitable We provide a wide-range of subjects and chol qualifications to enable each student to excel in the subject of their choice

Kodesh is not a subject, but our very essence.

Our שעורים run through the whole morning, every day of school. Our long-held belief in having a living role-model, a ע"ח ויר"ש who guides and nurtures his תלמידים for the full morning; not just in תורה but in דרך ארץ ויראת, is the central reason for our success.

We watch our תלמידים develop an excellent קשר with their Rebbeim who put in tremendous energy to ensure each תלמיד shteigs to reach his potential, and become budding and excited ת"ח.

ישיבת ערב (from Year 9), our חברותא evening learning in local בתי מדרש is a perfect example of how we nurture our boys to become גדולי.

We also have many שיחות מוסר from our Rebbeim and visiting תלמידי חכמים which twinned with class activities enable our תלמידים to grow into young men, ע"ח ויר"ש, well rounded in their דרך ארץ and menschelechkeit.

The curriculum

In recent years we have restructured the curriculum to ensure that our boys reach set standards year on year; that they leave confident in (גמרא (רש"י תוס וראשונים).

For חומש רש"י is split over four years, with each year learning their set חלק so that the full סדרה has been covered by the end of Year 10.

The הלכה curriculum has been revamped to ensure than in addition to הלכות מועדים, we also cover many areas of of הלכות שבת and הלכות תפלה (תפילין נטילת ידים ועוד עניני או"ח)

Progress Tracking

Central to our goal of knowing and maximising the progress of each תלמיד is the weekly visit to each class by the סגן-מנהל or for farhers in מנהל or נמרא or נמרא. These marks are periodically sent home to parents together with the results of written פארהער. The reports also include comments on התמדה and התמדה.

Our SEN department for those who need a little extra, or for those boys who are Gifted and Talented is the envy of many a school, with a rigorous programme in place to stretch those boys for whom it is suitable.

A Bespoke Programme

We offer a wide range of subjects to our students, and believe that we have built a unique curriculum that allows each and every one of students to achieve.

We believe fundamentally in a 'stage, not age' approach to education. Those students who are capable of completing expedited courses (such as Maths and Biblical Hebrew) are strongly encouraged

to complete these GCSE's early to enable them to move on to the AS & A2 qualifications in Year 10.

Achievement is at the centre of Pardes, and our subject-specialist teachers have a wealth of experience to create an environment that celebrates academic achievement and promotes success through stimulating, demanding and enjoyable learning both inside and outside the classroom.

The curriculum

Our curriculum is geared towards ensuring that when boys leave Pardes at the end of Year 10 or Year 11, they will have the opportunity to achieve a minimum of 7 GCSEs (or alternative eg iGCSE or Vocational) and two AS-Levels (Year 10). Those pupils who stay for Year 11 can build on this to achieve further A-Levels.

We invest heavily in resources and constantly review the curriculum provision to ensure that we are offering the best qualifications for our pupils.

Increased lesson allocation for core subjects was introduced last year as part of our annual curriculum review to lead into the new, more rigorous syllabi at GCSE.

Our rigorous process of target setting, monitoring and analysis ensures that we intervene where necessary to support students who are not achieving. **In Years 7** every student follows the same curriculum, studying:

English and Maths (streamed after Succos)

General Science

History

Geography

Creative Carousel (CDT & Safrus)

PE (off-site programme)

ICT

Nach (BH)

Jewish General Knowledge

Jewish History

From Year 8, students make their KS4 (GCSE) choices. As well as the subjects listed above, students are able to choose from a range of additional subjects including English Literature, Chemistry, Physics, Economics and Business Studies

Boys who stay for Year 11 are able to build a bespoke curriculum that can include AS or A2 Levels, additional GCSEs, the Extended Project Qualification or retake GCSEs where appropriate.
