At Weaverham High School, we recognise that the role of a Middle Leader is one of the most powerful roles in our school for driving our commitment to high quality learning, high quality teaching and everyday excellence for all. The impact that strong Middle leaders has, not just on the learning experience of pupils, but also on the growth and development of their own team of teachers, is immense and profound. Therefore, we are proud to invest in our Middle Leaders, both Curriculum and Pastoral, and we provide a Leadership programme for all our newly appointed Middle leaders – providing them with the necessary tools, expertise and support to thrive in their role, nurture talent in their team and make an extensive contribution to the wider school community. We also recognise that many of our talented Middle Leaders will also begin to consider Senior Leadership roles and so we also incorporate an aspiring SLT element into our programme for those experienced Middle leaders who wish to consider their next steps.

Our Weaverham High School Leadership Programme includes;

- Coaching with a member of the SLT.
- Peer Coaching and support with 'Outstanding' Middle Leader.
- Developmental Lesson Observation.
- Networking Opportunities.
- Training on emotional leadership and leadership styles.
- Attendance at CPD Seminars delivered by experienced Headteachers, Deputies and Senior Leaders.
- Completion of a whole school project linked to the SIP/SEF and presentation to SLT and wider staff body.
