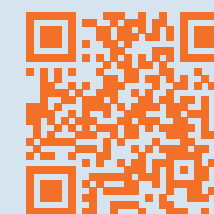

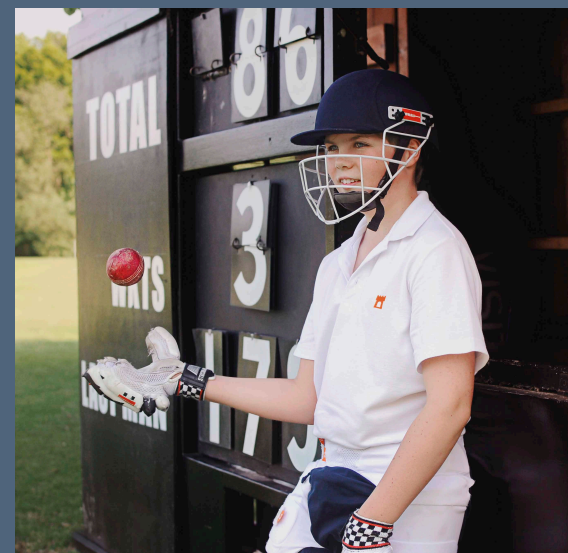
Good sport facilities include resurfaced Astro pitches, hard court and three-hole golf course – breadth of opportunity is the name of the game here.

Pupils delight in being outside and excitedly show wonder in what they discover.

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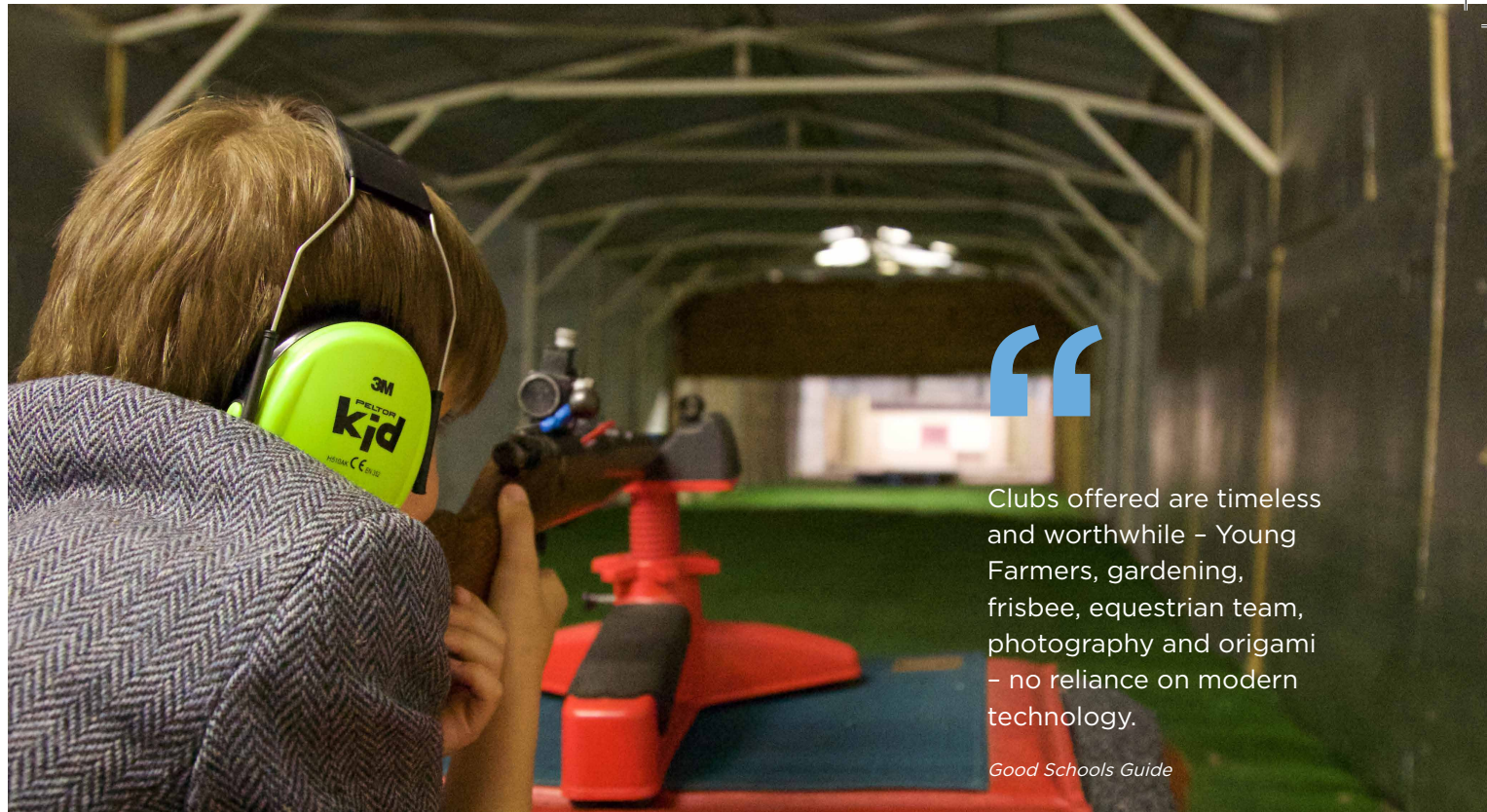


Explore

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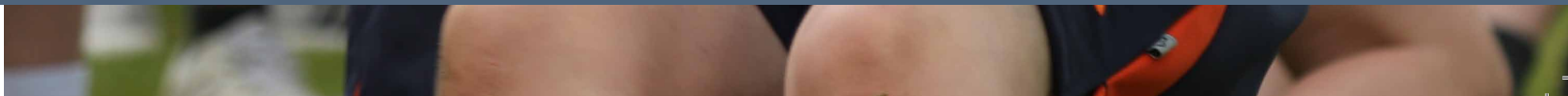
