Excellence: we aim for excellence in everything we do, no excuses!





The Middle Years Programme

We are extremely proud of our KS3 curriculum, in which academic excellence is achieved through teaching students to be lifelong learners and global citizens within a unique structure that promotes a nurturing transition to secondary school.

- Excellent teaching: Pupils have two main teachers, learning in a challenging but supportive environment where each student is known and enabled to maximise their potential.
- Our advanced stream are our most able students.
 These students receive a more challenging curriculum including a second language. This ensures that all of our students receive a curriculum well suited to their abilities and aspirations.
- Challenge and rigour through the INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE: Pupils experience high levels of challenge throughout their time here at Hartsdown, underpinned by the highly acclaimed International Baccalaureate curriculum, which culminates in the Career-Related Programme in the Sixth form.





TEAMWORK

Nurturing our students

At Hartsdown, we nurture our students by caring for them and challenging them to aim high.

The key elements of the pastoral care system are:

- Our house system: Students are placed in one of four houses and will remain in these for their time at Hartsdown. The houses are highly competitive with opportunities for inter house tournaments. This also ensures that their head of house gets to know all students as individuals.
- Tutor Groups: These are led by a teacher who mentors and encourages each child to make excellent academic progress and supports their pastoral needs.
- A high-expectations ethos: At Hartsdown, students learn values which help them to care for each other and become active, socially-aware and engaged citizens.
- Pastoral Team: Dedicated staff provide a wide range of individual and small group support in a range of settings which helps students to develop and thrive.







Beyond The Classroom

At Hartsdown, we believe that activities outside the classroom are invaluable in helping students to develop as individuals and to express their gifts and talents.

- Sporting Life: Hartsdown offers a full programme of sporting activities using our 3G pitch and extensive fields. Inter-school competitive sports give students opportunities to excel and lead.
- Embracing The Arts: Music and the creative and performing arts are a key priority for the school. All students have the opportunity to take part in regular school performances and express their creativity in art, design and drama.
- After School Clubs: the school runs a wide variety of clubs including homework clubs for various subjects, British Sign Language club and various sports clubs. Local, national and international school trips and business links are a key and growing part of our extra-curricular programme.
