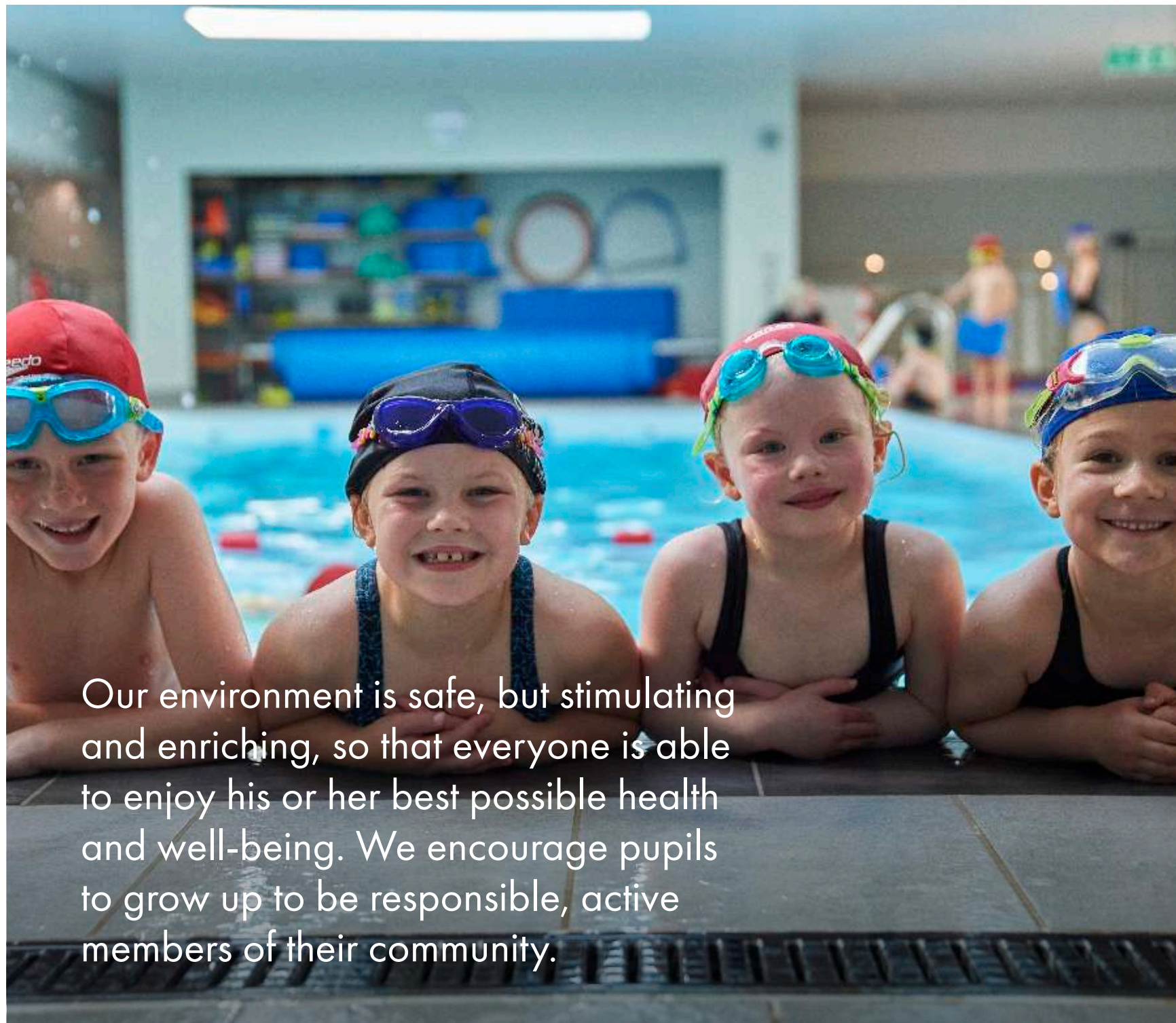


Fostering a balanced, enriching culture

To support this we encourage and support our teachers to be learners themselves and to seek constantly to be original and innovative in their delivery of the curriculum.

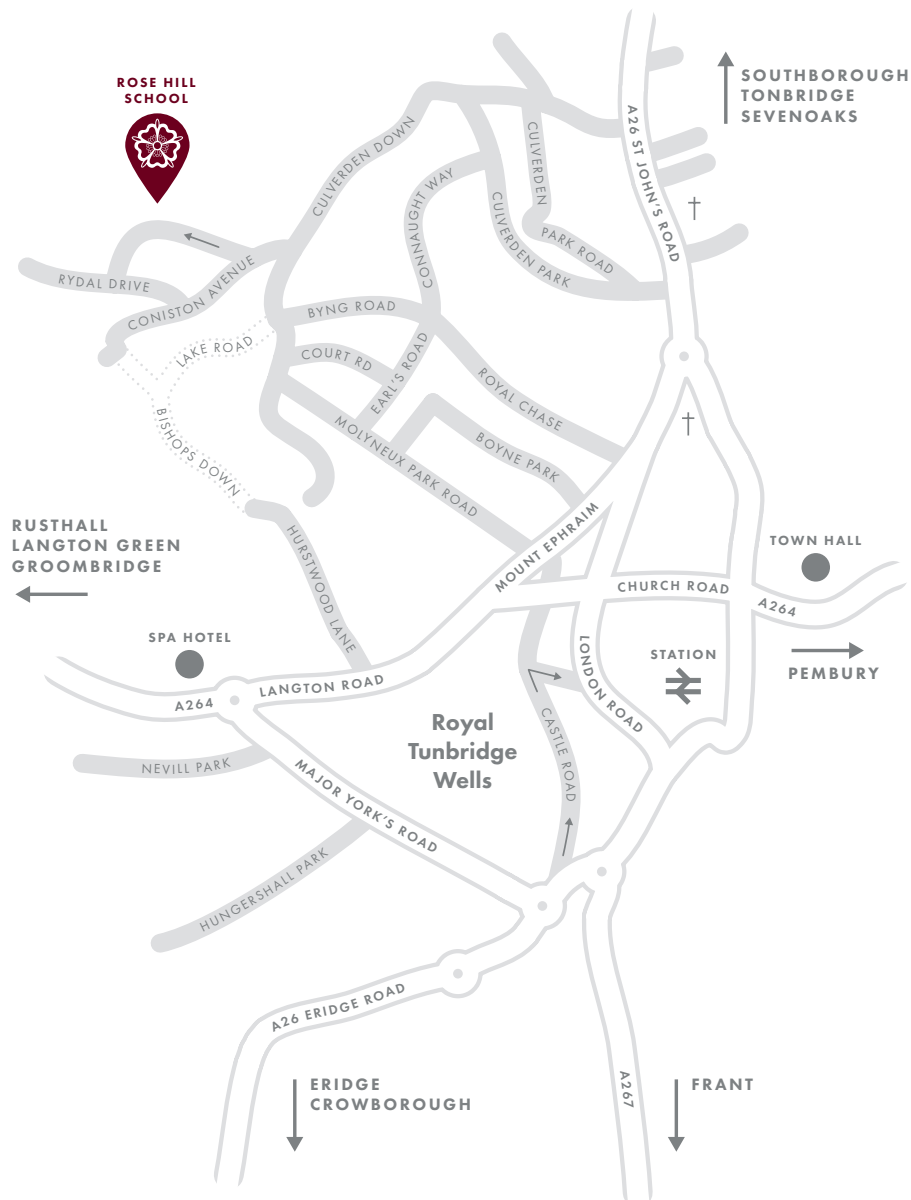

Please be aware that SatNavs will often misdirect drivers down Hurstwood Lane if approaching from the A26 Crowborough or A264 Langton Green.

In this instance, continue instead along Mount Ephraim, past the Travelodge on your left. 200m later turn left into Molyneux Park Road. Follow around a sharp S bend. After 100m, turn left into Coniston Avenue and our school entrance is immediately on the right.
