In September 2020 the brand new, state of the art building opened on London Road site in Balderton catering for 140 pupils from ages 3-18. As a generic special school, we provide an education for a wide range of needs. The facilities include a hydrotherapy pool, an Immersion room, a sensory room a soft play room and specialist curriculum rooms amongst many others. The school also has a Specialist Autism Hub as part of the new building.
