Helping Your Child Become Extraordinary

Whilst Penrice supports children of all abilities, we also make it our mission to provide huge opportunities that inspire and open doors for the most academically able.

In 2019, a report from the Sutton Trust identified that whilst just 7% of Britons are privately educated, they make up 39% of the leading professions. Here in St Austell, we are playing our part to change these national statistics by striving to offer Penrice students the best opportunities and experiences of any school.

The Scholarship Programme

Penrice offers a prestigious Scholarship Programme for academically high-performing students, running from Years 8 to 10. Your child could be one of currently 150 enrolled on this programme across the three year groups, providing a range of additional opportunities to inspire pupils.



YEAR 8 The 'Big Question Society'

Year 8 Scholars attend a series of group talks based on the Oxbridge questioning tool, sparking academic discussion and nurturing curiosity.



YEAR 9 Scholarship Lecture Series

In Year 9, scholars enjoy a lecture series run by staff across the school, creating a university-style experience to help students discover their passion and possible future aspirations.



YEAR 10 The Higher Project Qualification (HPQ)

The HPQ is an independent study project. It is an additional Level 2 Qualification, highly coveted by colleges and sixth forms, and is equivalent to a full GCSF.

The Mandarin Excellence Programme

Penrice Academy is the only school in Cornwall to offer the Mandarin Excellence Programme (MEP), an intensive curriculum offering in which settings must be rated Ofsted 'Outstanding' with strong performance in Modern Foreign Languages to be eligible to deliver.

This is an ambitious course designed to push the most academically able, starting in Year 7 and running right through until Year 11.

Being the only school in Cornwall to offer the Mandarin Excellence Programme is a fantastic opportunity for your child to stand out from the crowd, allowing them to learn the second-most spoken language in the world and opening doors to future opportunities.






Extraordinary Opportunities
