Your child is unique and here in the Pre School department we want to give them the best start on the road to lifelong learning.

Our experienced and enthusiastic staff do this in a caring, creative and fun environment in which your child can flourish. Our Pre School is led by a fully qualified teacher with many years of experience. We offer Pre School places to both girls and boys aged 3 to 4, welcoming children from the start of term after their third birthday.

Our Pre School class is known as the Wrens, and they have their own, purpose-built dedicated space in our brand new Infant School building in which to play, learn and grow. There is always an atmosphere of fun in the Wrens, where the children can be found dressing up, role playing, using the outdoor climbing equipment and sand or water play equipment as well as observing caterpillars transforming into butterflies, learning initial phonics and letter formations, modelling clay, painting and a wealth of other artistic pursuits. Visiting parents are always surprised at how articulate our Early Years pupils are - our small class sizes enable us to give each child the individual attention they need at this age.

Children are encouraged to progress at their own pace and to develop confidence in their own abilities right from the age of three. In the Wrens we offer both full and part-time places, with the Early Years Funding Scheme enabling reduced fees.

BEYOND the Classroom

We passionately believe in a broad and balanced curriculum. Drama and Music is a powerful, unique form of communication that can change the way pupils feel, think and act.

All children are actively encouraged to fulfil their potential, regardless of ability level and to share our enthusiasm and passion for music, so that pupils will develop a life-long love of music. Our aim is to foster individuality, creativity and expression, stretching and challenging pupils to further improve as performers and to be the very best they can be.

Pupils are given the opportunity to begin piano lessons in Reception and violin or cello lessons in Year 1. An infant choir and infant string orchestra rehearse every week to prepare for the many opportunities in our annual musical calendar.

All new children entering the Junior School are given the opportunity to try a wide range of instruments and are assessed on their suitability with recommendations then being made to parents. We have a wide and varied instrumental programme, including 3 choirs, 2 orchestras, 2 string ensembles, a wind band and theory groups to name but a few. Pupils perform individually in teatime concerts and have the chance to act and sing in a play or musical. There are numerous concerts for our choirs and ensembles who regularly perform in public.

Our House system encourages co-operative links between all year groups - and with the Senior School - and nurtures a sense of team spirit, competition and fun.

Parents and children (aged 2 to 4) who are considering joining Derby High in our Pre School are welcome to join us for our Derby High Little Learners Club events, held throughout the term, by booking a place with our Registrar.
