SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN – DISCLOSURE & BARRING CHECK

Exemption under the Exceptions Order to the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974

You are advised that all jobs at Turton School are subject to an Enhanced Disclosure Check via the Disclosure & Barring Service. This means that you are required to disclose any convictions, cautions, reprimands or final warnings which would not be filtered in line with current guidance including relevant dates.

A conviction will not necessarily be bar to obtaining employment, BUT failure to disclose any of the above criminal conviction will disqualify you from this appointment and may render you liable to dismissal without notice.

Disclosure checks will only be sought from the Disclosure & Barring Service after a candidate has been provided with a provisional offer of employment. If you have subscribed to the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) update service please indicate this on your application form

To protect your privacy when applying for a post, you can provide details of any convictions, cautions and bind-overs in a sealed envelope marked 'Private', for the attention of Barbara Makin, and return this with your completed application form.
