Our school offers children high quality learning experiences in a semi-rural setting, encouraging them to develop new skills and knowledge both in the classroom and the outdoors.

Castle Primary School provides an outstanding educational experience for children from 3 to 11 years old. We offer:

- a varied curriculum which stimulates children both physically and mentally.
- an environment where children feel safe and supported.
- a setting that is spacious and exciting.

Each child is encouraged to develop their independence and confidence whilst working together to learn new skills and art forms. We provide enriched outdoor learning sessions for all ages through our Forest School provision enabling every child to interact with our wonderful surroundings.

In September 2023 the Learning Alliance merged with The Learning for Life Partnership to form The Learning Partnership. This is a trust of 14 schools which will deliver education to 7500 pupils.

By working together and sharing all our expertise it is envisaged that our family of schools will continue to grow and develop, providing exceptional learning opportunities for all of our pupils. Castle Primary School is a feeder for Congleton High School.
