About Capel Manor College

From its humble beginnings as a horticulture college with a handful of students, today, Capel Manor College is London's leading environmental college, with five campuses across the capital and hundreds of courses in may diverse subjects including arboriculture, conservation, farming, floristry, garden design, horticulture, landscaping, veterinary studies, and zoology.

Our mission is to support the environment and green skills in London. Our vision is for an environmentally, economically and socially sustainable future for our students. As London's leading land-based college, we ensure that we play an active role within the local communities around our five campuses across the capital.

We work with hundreds of employers across London, providing our students with direct access to real-world industry know-how, experience and placements, including prestigious, world-class partners such as the Royal Parks, Buckingham Palace, The Dorchester Hotel, Royal Botanic Gardens Kew, British Association Landscape Industries, and the Zoological Society of London, to name a few.

Our campuses include some excellent facilities including laboratories, state-of-the-art greenhouses, stables, two zoos, a farm, an organic vineyard, over two-hundred acres of gardens and woodland, a flowers shop, and a dog grooming parlour. We are continuing to invest in our facilities, including a substantial redevelopment of our Mottingham Campus. Once complete, the amount of teaching space at the site will be doubled and the quality of the learning environment will be greatly improved. The project will result in the creation of a truly inspiring teaching facility, built employing the latest sustainable and low-carbon technologies.

The College is also open to the public throughout the year for families to enjoy and our annual events include a classic and vintage car show and the Hertfordshire heavy horse and country show. We also run events at Halloween, Easter and Christmas and our picturesque gardens are available for wedding hire.

The College has a rich history dating back to 1968, when the first students joined the College. Over the years, the College has welcomed a number of famous visitors, including Her Royal highness Princess Anne, who opened the Royal College of Animal Management and Saddlery in 2015, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, who opened the Old Manor House Garden in 2010 and His Majesty King Charles III who opened the Duchess of Devonshire Pavilion in his role as the Prince of Wales in 2000.

Today the College has over two-thousand learners immersed in a hands-on learning environment and guided by industry experts to help them reach their full potential.



Our campuses

Crystal Palace Park Campus

Our campus in Crystal Palace Park is located in the National Sports Centre, serving as an education hub for environmental learning in South London. Students are able to contribute to the welfare of the Park and its green areas, as well as care for our animals at Crystal Palace Park Farm which is open to the public.



Enfield Campus

Our Enfield Campus is surrounded by 30 acres of idyllic parkland that includes 60 gardens and landscapes, a beautiful Georgian manor house, café, flower shop, dog grooming salon, and zoo with over 75 species of animals. We also run nearby Forty Hall Farm, a certified organic farm that spans 150 acres.



Gunnersbury Park Campus

Our Gunnersbury Park Campus has a friendly and community-driven atmosphere. Our students have access to the highest quality of staff and technical support, as well as to the practical facilities within the College's walled garden. We also have working access to parts of Gunnersbury Park itself.



Mottingham Campus

Located in South East London, our Mottingham Campus currently offers a range of courses at a variety of levels. Students can choose to study from a vast array of environmental courses including: agriculture, animal management, floristry, garden design and horticulture.



Regent's Park Campus

Located within the Inner Circle of Regent's Park, our Regent's Park Campus works in partnership with The Royal Parks to increase the options for horticulture and garden design training open to people living and working in inner London.

Staff working at Capel Manor College enjoy a number of benefits. A list of the key benefits can be found below:

Salary Capel Manor College offers a generous salary. Qualified Lecturers can earn up to

£41,045 per annum. Salaries are inclusive of London Weighting, which varies

depending on campus.

Pension Lecturing staff are eligible to join the Teacher's Pension Scheme and support staff



The Recruitment Process

For details of our current vacancies and to apply, please visit www.capel.ac.uk/vacancies. To apply for a position with the College, an application form must be completed and CVs will not be accepted.

Short listed candidates will be contacted shortly after the closing date and invited to attend a selection process. The selection process will typically involve a panel interview with the hiring managers and a member of Human Resources. Depending on the role, the selection process may involve additional elements. For example, candidates for lecturing roles may be asked to prepare and deliver a lesson on a specified topic. Selection processes for support or managerial roles may involve completing a work-based assessment or delivering a presentation. Selection processes will typically be conducted on campus and candidates will be required to bring three forms of identity with them when attending. This is because successful applicants are required to undergo Enhanced Disclosure clearance (DBS) from the Criminal Records Bureau.

We appreciate that applicants can spend a considerable amount of time completing an application form, so ensure that we notify unsuccessful applicants that their application has not been successful at the earliest opportunity.

If you are successful after the selection process, you will be sent a formal job offer by the Human Resources Department. Offers of appointment are generally subject to two satisfactory references, medical clearance, confirmation of an individual's right to work in the UK, a DBS check at Enhanced Level and Children's Barred List check and a six-month probationary period.

Capel Manor College is committed to creating and promoting an equal, diverse and inclusive workforce that enables those working at the College to achieve their full potential. We are committed to achieving a truly representative workforce and therefore welcome applications from all sections of the community.
