53% of entries passed at grades A and A\*; 77%\* of entries were passed at grades A\*, A and B; 92% were grades A\* to C.

The average UCAS tariff score per candidate was 137 (based on grade A\*=56, A=48 pts., B=40, etc.)

74% of our Y13 students each gained at least one grade  $A^*/A$  pass, 52% each gained two or more grade  $A^*/A$  passes including 65 students who each gained three or more  $A^*/A$  grades.
