The pass rate at A Level was 100\%.
The average number of ' $A$ ' Levels gained per candidate was 3.2.
$53 \%$ of entries passed at grades $A$ and $A^{*} ; 77 \% *$ of entries were passed at grades $A^{*}, A$ and $B ; 92 \%$ were grades A* to C.

The average UCAS tariff score per candidate was 137 (based on grade $A^{*}=56, A=48$ pts., $B=40$, etc.)
$74 \%$ of our Y13 students each gained at least one grade A*/A pass, $52 \%$ each gained two or more grade A*/A passes including 65 students who each gained three or more A*/A grades.


## GCSE SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 155 pupils in Year 11 in 2022/23. Pupils sat reformed GCSE specifications which awarded 9 to 1 grades.
