A world of discovery

Sparking our pupils' natural curiosity lies at the heart of our approach to teaching and learning. Pupils are encouraged to question, to experiment and to challenge their own thinking, to discover, to wonder and dare to go further. We nurture inquisitiveness through innovative and inspiring teaching, a broad and challenging curriculum, and a wealth of co-curricular activities.

From Nursery upwards all pupils are taught PE, French, Music, Dance and Drama. In EYFS we also include regular Forest School sessions. ICT, German, Spanish, Art, DT and Science are introduced in later years. The core subjects of English, Maths, History, Geography and RE are taught with an imaginative approach, encouraging pupils to make connections between subjects to develop a wider understanding. As well as a broad range of academic subjects, we excel in music, the performing arts and sport, and encourage creativity, courage and ambition, whether on stage or on the playing field.

Outstanding facilities

Within our extensive five acre school grounds, we offer superb facilities. Our splendid Library, housed in the old chapel, state-of-the-art IT suite, music block, art and DT classrooms and newly refurbished Science lab all enrich our pupils' learning experience.

Freedom to explore

Our large playing field, dedicated playgrounds for Nursery, Pre-Prep and Prep and three Forest schools, provide our pupils with ample space to explore, to be adventurous and to enjoy learning outdoors. With the open expanse of the heath on our doorstep, and Greenwich Park also within a short walk, we offer children an idyllic school location.

Forest School

Outdoor learning is an important part of the curriculum at Blackheath Prep. Nursery and Reception pupils have regular outdoor sessions in our Forest schools and Garden of Imagination. We give them the freedom to build dens, climb trees, make campfires and splash about in mud in a safe outdoor setting. Mini adventures are encouraged, and our qualified Forest School leaders provide the opportunities for our pupils to discover the natural world first-hand, from pond dipping and bird watching to identifying trees and plants.

Our Nursery

Most pupils join us in Nursery aged 3 years old. Play is at the heart of our provision for our youngest pupils. We create a fun and relaxed environment, providing them with the freedom to enjoy a superb range of stimulating activities in our well-equipped nursery classrooms and dedicated playgrounds. Curiosity, discovery and interaction is encouraged, enabling pupils to develop their skills, work collaboratively with others, explore, observe, experiment and solve problems.

We follow the principles of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework with a strong emphasis on developing children's literacy and number sense. French, Music, Dance, PE and Drama are also offered and taught by specialist teachers.

Outdoor learning is a key part of our curriculum and come rain or shine, our youngest pupils are given the freedom to explore and have fun in our Forest Schools where they get to enjoy the natural world.

Our Pre-Prep

The Pre-Prep welcomes children from Reception through to the end of Year 2. Learning in our Pre-Prep is vibrant and exciting, with a wide variety of subjects taught through a creative curriculum approach. In Pre-Prep we encourage a sense of independence and inspire pupils to explore and question the world around them. We nurture each child, celebrate their strengths, and support them fully so they can flourish and reach their full potential.

The Reception classes follow an enhanced Early Years curriculum. This is designed to prepare them for progression into Years 1 and 2 where children are taught a broad range of subjects in dedicated lessons for Literacy, Mathematics, Science, Geography, History, Computing, French, Music, PE and RE.

Our Prep

As our pupils move into the Prep at Year 3 we focus on building their confidence and encourage them to continue being inquisitive learners who think critically.

Lessons include teaching by specialist teachers, with form teachers also providing excellent pastoral care for their pupils. By the time they reach Year 6, our pupils have benefitted from a broad and stimulating education and are well-equipped for the next stage of their education.

Moving on

In Year 5 and Year 6 we prepare our pupils well for their 11+ and senior school entrance exams, as well as supporting our parents in the choices that they are making for their child. Our pupils achieve considerable success in entrance exams for both the maintained and the independent sectors and an impressive number of our leavers are offered scholarships.





Shine on stage

The arts are a key part of the curriculum at Blackheath Prep. We firmly believe that creativity is fundamental to children's development, confidence and wellbeing.

Feel the beat

Music is at the heart of our school life. From Nursery to Year 6, all pupils receive at least two timetabled music lessons a week and learn at least one instrument, taught by one of our ten highly experienced peripatetic staff. With six choirs, two orchestras, a wind band, a jazz band, recorder and flute ensembles, and a guitar club, we ensure that there are plenty of opportunities for pupils to develop a passion and appreciation for music.

Let's dance

Dance lessons at Blackheath Prep are taught by a specialist teacher and are purposively designed to be fun and inclusive with an emphasis on the positive effect that movement can have on our pupils' wellbeing. Dance genres and styles from around the world are explored, including jive, salsa, bhangra, hip hop, ballet, contemporary, African dance, jazz, flamenco and disco.

Take centre stage

From Nursery upwards, all pupils have weekly Drama lessons, taught by specialist teachers with a background in professional theatre. Every child is given the opportunity to shine during the school year and perform in school assemblies, the Christmas nativity and our wonderful end of year productions.

Inspiring creativity

Our art and design curriculum is designed to enable experimentation and self-expression, encouraging each child to enjoy being creative and build confidence in their own ability.

Get creative

In our well-equipped art studio, pupils are encouraged to develop a range of skills and techniques in different media, from drawing and painting to wire sculpture and ceramics.

Make it

Pupils explore the designed and made world through fun and practical woodwork, model making and 3D design lessons in our dedicated Design & Technology classroom. They are encouraged to develop an understanding of aesthetics, social and environmental issues and gain practical experience of problem solving through design and working in a team.

Our superb on-site sport facilities include tennis and netball courts, cricket nets, indoor gymnasium hall, and a large playing field and sports pavilion.

Our specialist PE teachers provide expert tuition in a wide range of sports including athletics, cricket, football, tag rugby, softball, lacrosse, hockey, gymnastics and swimming. Through co-operative and competitive games, we build our pupils' confidence and ensure that every child can participate in the inter-house events programme.

We also offer extension opportunities to our talented pupils and external fixtures against other schools, enabling them to be part of the wider sporting community and to excel at a competitive level.

Digital citizens

Digital innovation is at the heart of the curriculum at Blackheath Prep. All year groups are taught in our purpose-built IT suite where pupils develop and challenge their skills as they experiment with modern technology and systems.

Lessons are centred on digital citizenship, computer science and the use of information communication technology. We integrate cross-curricular teaching with Maths, Science and Design and Technology and encourage our children to explore these links as they develop their digital proficiency





Enrichment

Our pupils enjoy an exciting programme of co-curricular activities, trips and events all year round. Visits to museums, galleries, historic buildings theatres and attractions provide a fun day out of the classroom and inspiration for creativity on their return to school. In Years 4, 5 and 6 we introduce our popular residential trips, including outdoor adventure and water sports activities.

Visiting speakers are an important part of our co-curricular offer with inspirational talks given by polar explorers, Paralympians, astronomers, scientists, authors and illustrators to name but a few. Parents also share their professional expertise, and others bring to life the customs and practices of a wide range of cultures and religions.

Happiness is key

We work hard to ensure that our school has happy, confident, resilient and inquisitive children at its heart. The wellbeing of each and every child is fundamental to everything we do and every pupil is nurtured throughout their time with us.

Pupils are supported by all staff in weekly assemblies, Smart School Council meetings, circle time activities, termly pastoral mentoring sessions and a bespoke PSHE curriculum. We help them to develop the courage to believe in themselves, to try new things, to be brave and to be tenacious. We encourage pupils to learn from mistakes and rise to challenges. We teach them to learn about the rights and responsibilities of others, and to respect and value the richness and diversity of our society.







Learning support

Children may experience learning challenges for all sorts of reasons. Our learning support provision is embedded into the teaching culture of the school to ensure help is provided where it's needed.

Our Learning Support department work closely with teaching staff across the school to identify and nurture a wide range of abilities and talents. They create an inclusive and motivational atmosphere that supports the educational and pastoral needs of pupils. This include children with SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities), EAL (English as an Additional Language), and exceptionally able students. In class, teachers and teaching assistants provide additional support both in small groups and individually.

Eating well

Lunchtime is an important part of our school day.
Our pupils look forward to lunch and come together to enjoy a tasty and healthy meal with their classmates.
We offer an imaginative, weekly changing menu which uses fresh ingredients and the finest British produce sourced from local farmers, growers and artisan suppliers.

In collaboration with our catering partner, Holroyd Howe, pupils take part in food education classes. Tasting sessions encourage them to try new types of food, exotic fruit and vegetables, and learn about seasonality. They also get the chance to try cooking for themselves, making fresh pasta, sushi and baking bread.

Wraparound care

To help meet the needs of parents, we offer wraparound care providing a relaxed and sociable environment at the start and end of each school day (additional charges apply).

Breakfast Club and Late Stay

Breakfast Club runs from 7.30am on weekday mornings during term time and is open to all pupils from Nursery upwards. Games, activities and a hearty breakfast sets each child up for the day ahead. A late stay provision is available until 5pm following our after-school clubs. Children can relax and socialise with friends, supervised by our friendly staff who occupy them with indoor and outdoor games, construction toys, and art and craft activities.

School Clubs

We offer a wealth of exciting clubs and activities enabling pupils to try new things and explore favourite passions. Over 70 lunchtime and after school clubs take place every week, including art, coding and Minecraft, hip-hop and jazz dance, woodwork, gardening, sport and magic clubs.
