# Safe, Happy and Positive -Strong Pastoral Care

We have a large team of staff whose main responsibility is to support and care for students every day. At any time in their school career students can face challenges. Friendship problems, worries about their studies, difficulties outside of school. At Manchester Academy all our students know who they can talk to if they need help, advice or practical information. This support ensures that bullying is dealt with swiftly and effectively. We know bullying can rapidly affect a student's well-being and therefore if it happens, we will deal with it quickly and firmly.

Our pastoral team develop excellent relationships with our parents and carers and this team working is vital so that we can work together to support our students. We will be in contact to celebrate achievements and to discuss any issues that arise. We also want families to get in touch if they feel worried about anything. This helps us understand what's going on so that our support can be tailored and address any problems that may occur.

Excellent behaviour underpins this feeling of safety and happiness - building a positive work ethic across every lesson. We expect excellent behaviour and attendance and our students are clear what will happen if they fall short of our high expectations. During lessons, around the Academy building and at social times, our students model excellence and this collective responsibility is part of the reason why the Academy's reputation has been transformed. We want excellent behaviour every day and for our students to dress in a business-like, smart way so they feel ready to work and there is a clear difference between being in work mode and out of school mode. It goes without saying that to make Manchester magic, you have to be in school every day so attendance and punctuality must be immaculate.

## English as an Additional Language

Manchester Academy has a dedicated team and programme of study for students whose first language is not English, taught by specialist staff and designed to rapidly improve students' reading ability, vocabulary and pronunciation skills. Students who have struggled to learn the necessary literacy skills before joining us also benefit from this programme, which aims to accelerate students' language skills, so that they can access the full curriculum as quickly as possible.

Manchester Academy is blessed with outstanding modern facilities, equipped to the highest possible standards which we continuously improve. These include:

- A brand new, £500,000 sports pitch and facility built in partnership with the Premier League and the Manchester United Foundation
- Outstanding sports facilities to develop a wide range of sports
- WiFi across the building and numerous tech facilities;

- ICT suites providing the latest hi-tech equipment and software;
