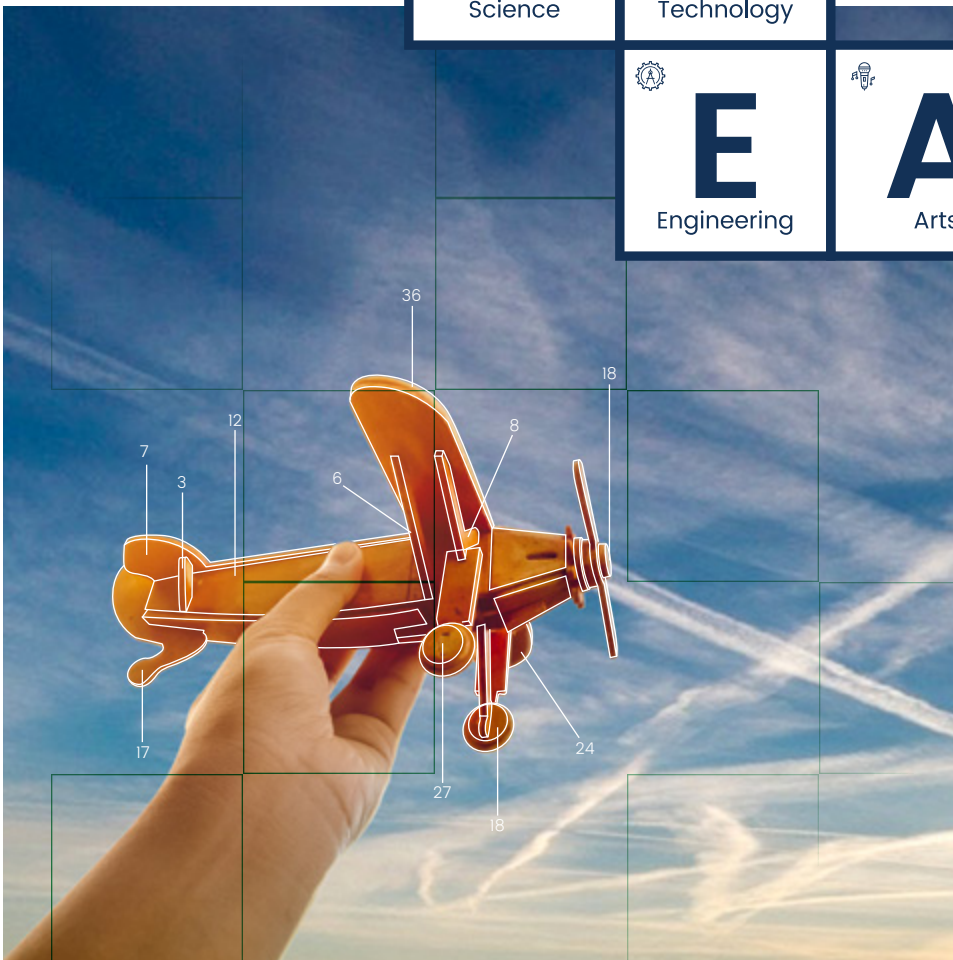

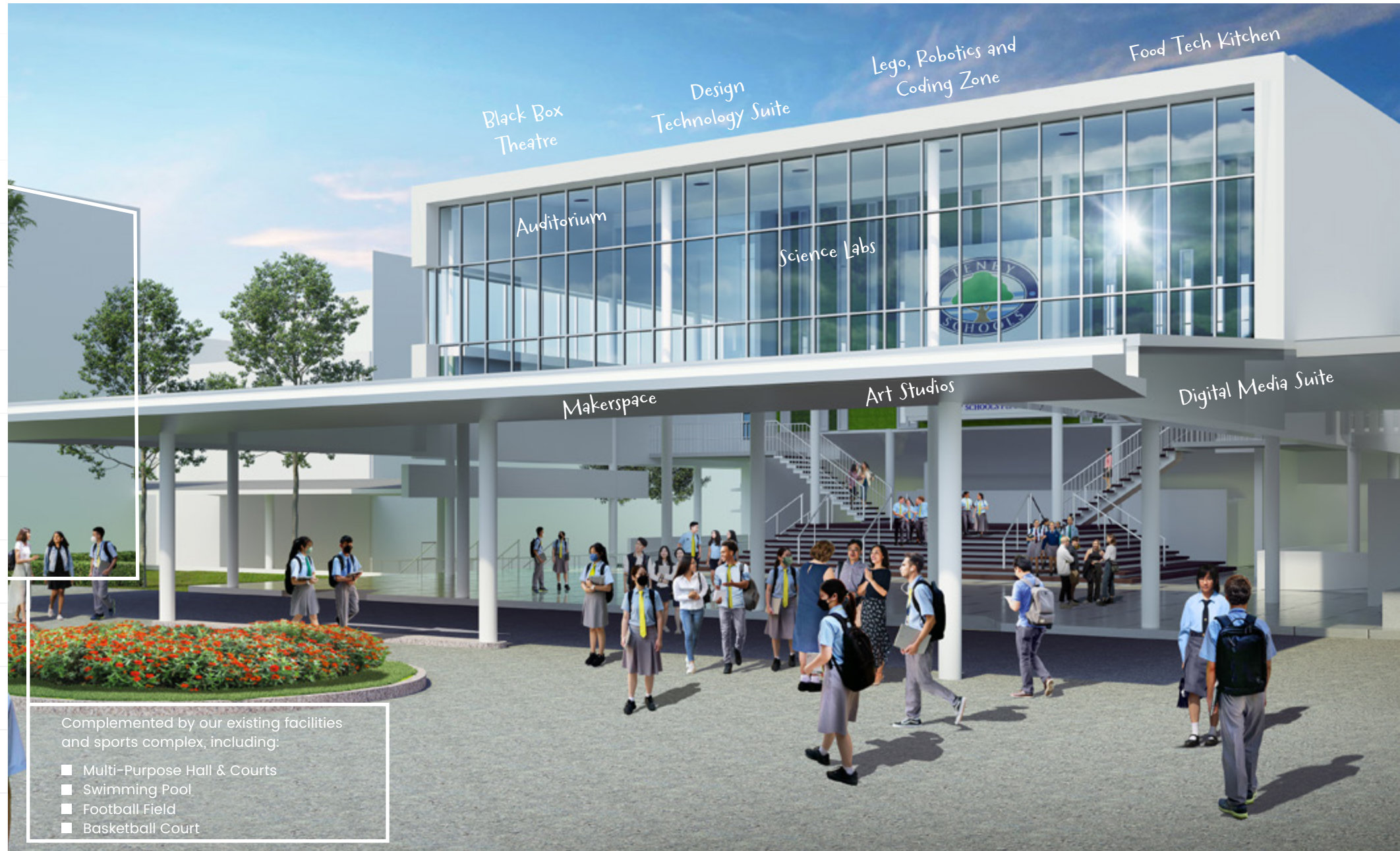

The Evolution of Tenby Schools

Our story begins in 1960 when Ms Dorothy Nelson-Doig started a kindergarten for British expatriates in Ipoh, named after her hometown of Tenby, Wales. This quickly grew to become one of Malaysia's first international schools, Tenby International School (TIS), Ipoh.

Over the next 40 years, Tenby Schools would undergo great changes, just like its adopted home. And, as the number of expatriates stationed in Malaysia fell, we saw the opportunity to also introduce the Malaysian National curriculum, having two schools share one campus.

In January 2005, the Tenby Schools group acquired Sekolah Sri Inai in Penang which was founded by the Augustine family in the early 1980s. It was the first private school

on the island to offer a Malaysian curriculum and was later renamed Sekolah Sri Tenby.

In 2007, we opened Tenby International School Penang and four years later, in September 2011, to support the growth of our students, we moved both schools to a new purpose-built campus in the prestigious suburb of Tanjung Bungah.

Today, we stand as one of the most recognisable school brands in the country, with six campuses around Malaysia. Find us in Ipoh, Penang, Shah Alam, Semenyih, Kota Kemuning and Johor.

Penang is an incredible island attracting demand from both expatriate and local families for a global education. This is reflected

in the vibrant diversity of our school, with more than 33 different nationalities benefiting from our enriched British curriculum.

We've gained a solid reputation for excellence in education. The school is fully accredited to both the Council of International Schools (CIS) and Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). We consistently rank as one of the highest achieving international schools in Penang when it comes to academic results, and our excellence can be seen across our schools.

A significant milestone on our journey is Tenby Schools Group being acquired by International Schools Partnership (ISP) in January 2018. We are proud to be supported by this global network of more

than 64 schools in 17 countries, committed to a learning philosophy of 'getting better'.

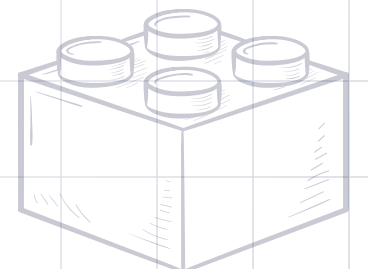
Each of our mini but mighty nursery and reception children have their own learning style and pace.

Supported by our specialist teachers with the guidance of the International Early Years Curriculum (IEYC), we have created a child-focused, holistic and fun learning experience that allows our youngest students to learn effectively and with joy.

The IEYC covers all the aspects of the Early Years Foundation Stage provision. Small group activities are carefully planned to develop important numeracy and literacy skills while

supporting each student's developmental needs. A lesson might involve playing with the BeeBots but really children are learning the fundamentals of coding. They might build structure out of lollipop sticks linked to the story of Three Little Pigs but in truth they are becoming immersed in the world of design and engineering.

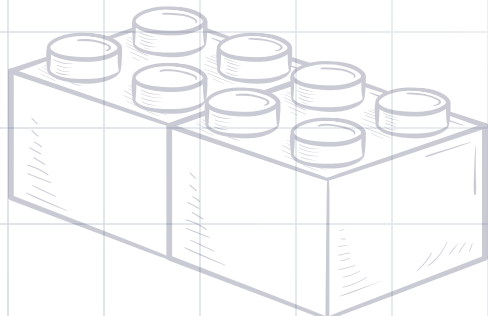
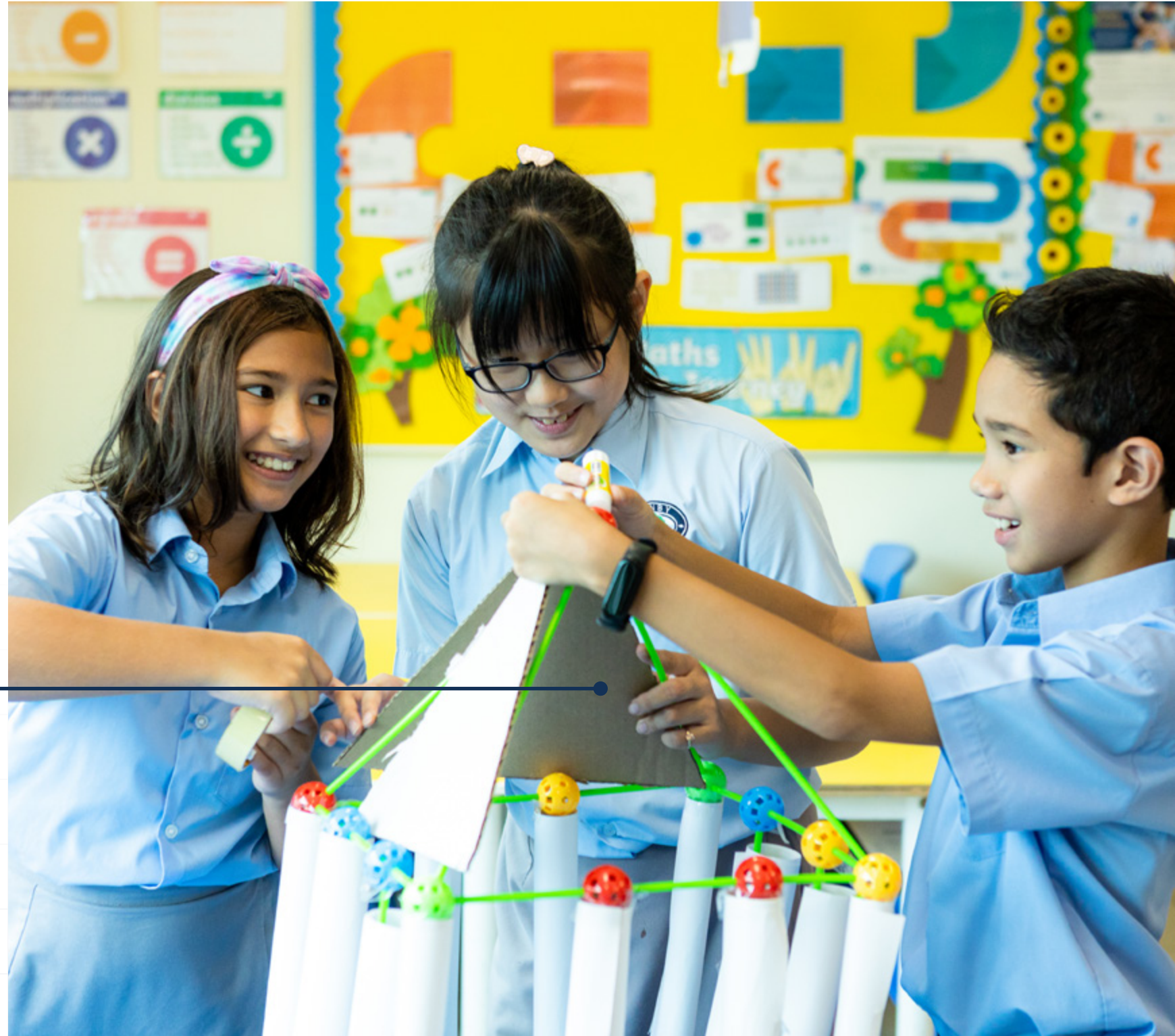

At Tenby International Secondary School, we aspire to achieve, together. Our students achieve well above their expected targets at IGCSE by engaging with a personalised programme of study that allows them to follow their passions, while working towards a basket of qualifications that will be the key that opens any door to their future, that they choose.

As an inclusive school, it has been terrific to travel with our students on their individual pathways to success. In 2022, 59% of all IGCSE grades were A* / A grade and more students than ever surpassed their individual

targets. We aim high and support all students to climb the ladder of success.

As a school, we support our students to achieve more than 'just' phenomenal examination grades. Secondary education is also about developing the whole person. It is at this stage that Amazing Learning moves beyond the classroom and makes a greater impact on the character of students. We follow the world-renowned English Curriculum throughout the Secondary years that deliver a broad and balanced programme of learning. This includes not just the 'academic' suite of subjects but also includes programmes that support the whole child. For example our Life Skills and Leadership lessons cover personal, health and social education to equip our students with the skills they need to navigate the world they will emerge into as young adults.

This includes an extensive programme to support them as they make choices about Post 16 and Post 18 study pathways.

Our aim is to develop holistic learners who get better - academically, socially, emotionally and more - through good struggle inside and outside the classroom, and become independent, self-motivated individuals ready for the next step in their educational journey.

Achieve the Remarkable

There's more to you than a grade can show but we want to reassure you that our students make amazing progress.

We aim high and support our students to aspire to these high targets. We use CAT 4 to measure students' aptitudes and establish ambitious targets. The CAT 4 assessments that we use also help us to build a programme that reflects the unique nature of our students' learning preferences and strengths. This helps us to ensure our students are consistently placed within a good struggle that leads to success.

CAT 4 is based on years of research and enables us to measure our students against the progress of over half a million students worldwide. We know our CAT 4 targets are ambitious but we believe that if we aim high and aspire to achieve, every student can exceed their expectations.

In 2022, over 90% of our IGCSE subjects exceeded their CAT 4 targets demonstrating real added value for our students.



On average, our students achieved well above their international peers in the following subjects:

English First Language:

Students achieved 1.03 grades above their peers.

Mathematics:

Students achieved 1.0 grades above their peers.

Global Perspectives:

Students achieved 1.0 grades above their peers.

English Literature:

Students achieved 1.31 grades above their peers.

Biology / Chemistry and Physics:

Students achieved 0.85 grades above their peers.

Design Technology:

Students achieved 1.55 grades above their peers.

ICT:

Students achieved 2.3 grades above their peers.

Students can take the school day up a notch by connecting with peers across year groups and

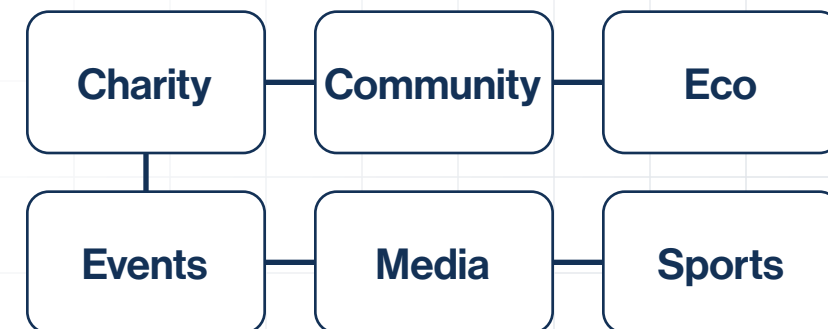
become part of the Student Leadership Council or its amazing sub groups.

We encourage everyone to choose challenges and activities that interests them through our global network with the International Schools Partnership (ISP).



Move Your Body to Boost Your Mind

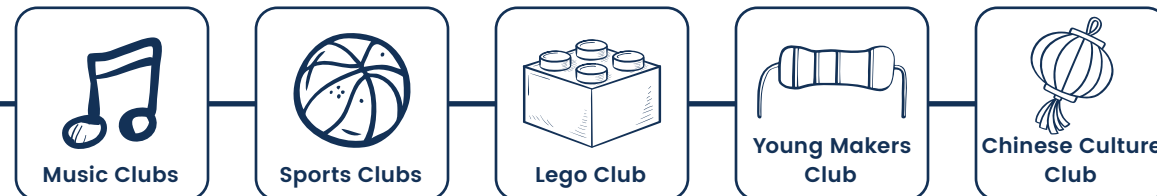
Being physically active can improve your brain health! Here children have as many opportunities as possible to engage in physical activity – be

Happy students learn better. When you feel valued and well supported you can thrive in your learning.

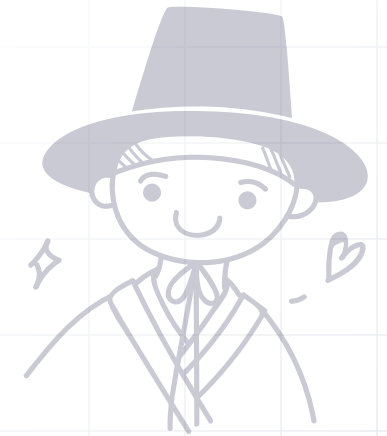
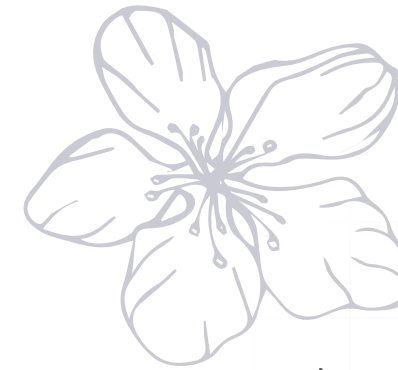
Our campus has a Designated Safeguarding Team and all of our staff – including cleaning and caterer contractors – have completed safeguarding training.

If a student feels unwell there is a school nurse and a team of teachers and support staff are first-aid trained to care of them.

Strong relationships between home and school are key to learners' success. In primary school, the class teacher is the contact point and regular communication takes place through a variety of safe channels from face to face to online platforms to share your child's learning journey.

In secondary, students are assigned a form tutor to oversee the students' academic, pastoral, and co-curricular progress on a regular basis. The form tutor is the parent's first point of call. Your child has daily contact with their form tutor to build a positive relationship to support your child through secondary school.

When students feel supported and nurtured as they learn they are more likely to take risks, be curious about the world they live in and develop their social skills for future success.

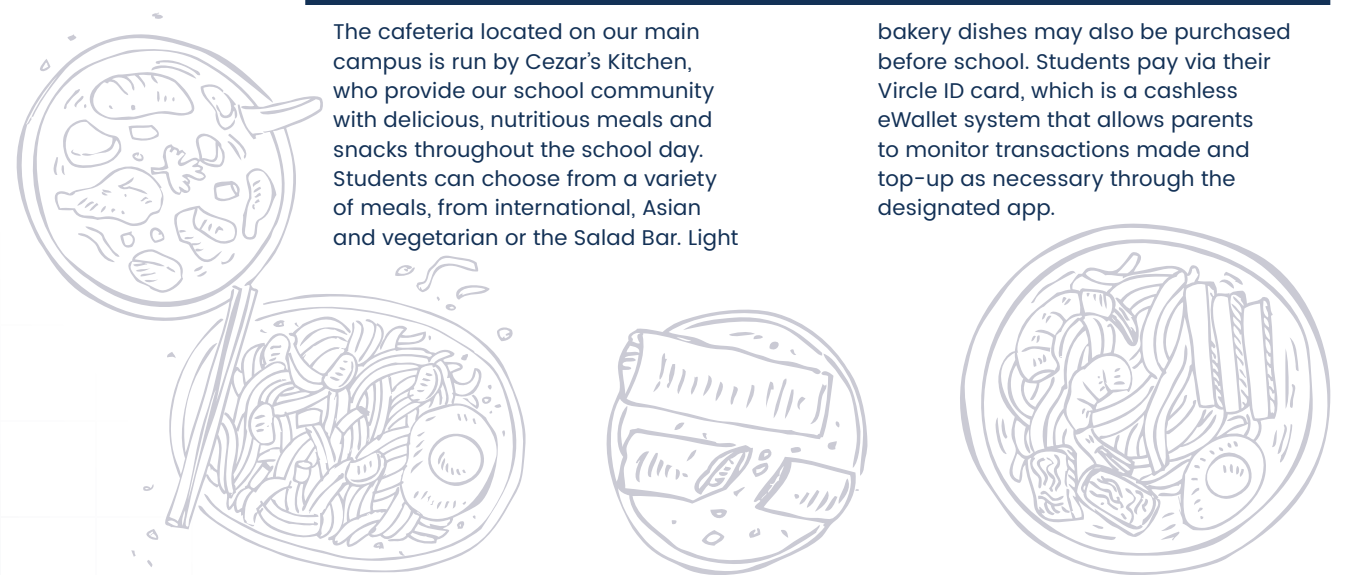
Students continue to be embraced by a supportive community even after they have left school. All ISP students can join events that connect them with other students from around the world.

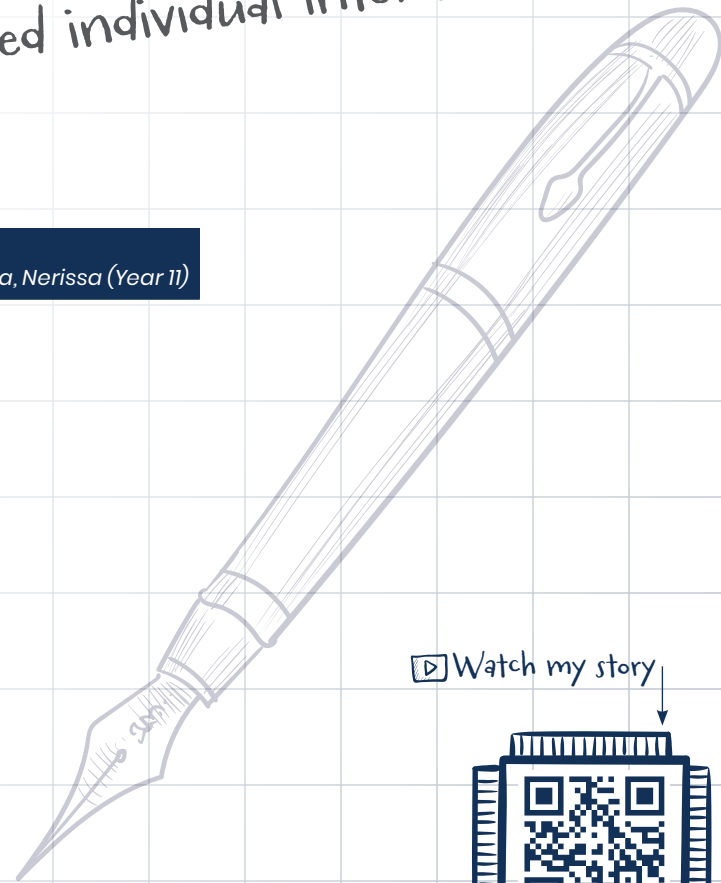

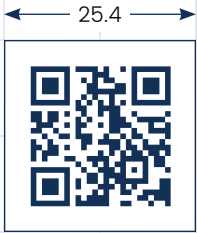

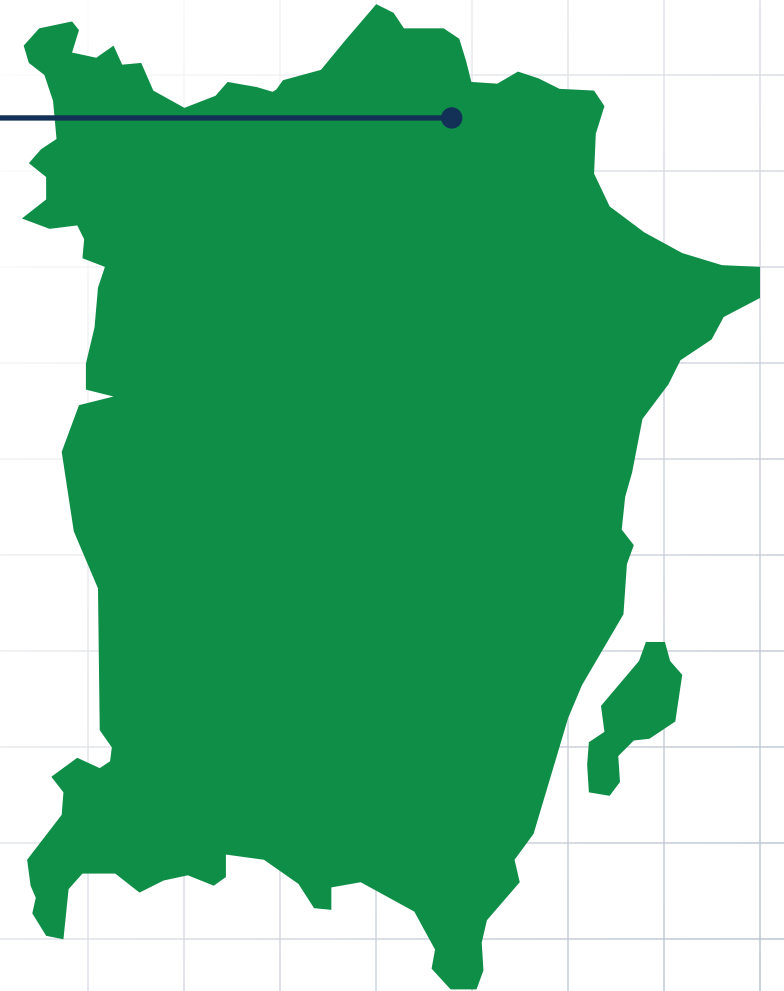
