St. Paul's was the first British School to be established in São Paulo and offers an Anglo-Brazilian curriculum, embracing the best of both cultures. Almost 100 years old, we draw on our proud heritage as the first British school in Latin America to be recognised as a British School Overseas (BSO) by the UK government.

Pupils at St. Paul's School benefit from both its rich history and its innovative, modern facilities. The school occupies the same 1.8-hectare site acquired in 1927 and is situated in the leafy residential area aptly named Jardins. The school is organised on the English public school model.



## CURRICULUM

St. Paul's School provides a carefully structured, integrated and diversified curriculum. The school's curriculum has its foundation in the English National Curriculum incorporating the UK National Curriculum, Cambridge IGCSEs and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. We also incorporate the requirements laid out by the Brazilian Core Curriculum.

Pupils prepare for IGCSE courses in Form 4 and Form 5 (Y10 & 11, Grades 9 & 10). All those in Lower and Upper 6 (Y12 & 13, Grades 11 & 12), take the full IB Diploma.

We do not rank students nor calculate GPA.

The school also offers a full enrichment programme, which includes a wide range of clubs and societies and a house system, as well as ample opportunities to develop skills in creative arts, music, and sports, both inside and outside the classroom. This programme underpins our aims to instill a life-long love for learning, self-development, and a belief in one's abilities in all pupils.



## THE IB PROGRAMME

The IB Diploma is a 2-year course of study. All IB students take 6 subjects from different academic areas of which 3 are studied at higher level and 3 at standard level.

IB subjects are graded on a 1-7 scale with 7 being the highest score. To qualify for the award of the IB Diploma a student must receive a combined score of 24 points across 6 subjects with at least 12 points from higher level subjects and a minimum of 9 points from standard level subject.

The maximum points that can be awarded to an IB Diploma student is the full score of 45 with 42 points generated across the 6 subjects and 3 bonus points derived from Theory of Knowledge and the Extended Essay.



# Theory of Knowledge (ToK)

2-year 100-hour course about critical thinking and inquiry into the nature of knowledge, assessed through an oral presentation and a 1600word essay



# Creativity, Action and Service (CAS)

A journey of selfdiscovery in which students participate in a range of activities to meet learning outcomes

## THE IB SUBJECTS

All pupils must take English, Mathematics, and Portuguese either at Standard Level or Higher Level.

3 other IB subjects can be selected from:

English Language & Literature, English Literature, Portuguese Language & Literature, Portuguese Literature, Mathematics Analysis & Approaches, Mathematics Applications & Interpretations, Business Management, Economics, Global Politics, History, Geography, Brazilian Social Studies, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Systems and Societies, Computer Science, Film, Theatre, Visual Arts, Spanish as a Second Language, Portuguese as a Second Language, and French as a Second Language.


