Established in 2012, King's College School was the first **British curriculum** school in Panama offering classes to children from Early Years to Year 13.

In 2019, King's joined **Inspired Education Group**, the global leading group of premium international schools in the world, currently comprising of more than 111 schools across 24 countries.

In August 2022, King's moved onto a new site in the Clayton area of Panama city, providing our students with a new **state-of-the-art campus**.

Its **first graduating class** was in 2020.

King's is accredited by British Schools Overseas (BSO) and was appraised as "Outstanding in all areas" in the most recent audit (June 2023).



King's is an International Baccalaureate (IB) world school offering the IB Diploma Program to its Year 12 and Year 13 students.



King's operates under a license granted by the Ministry of Education in Panama (MEDUCA).

King's is also part of the Latin American Heads Conference (LAHC) and the Association of British Schools overseas (AoBSO).

CURRICULUM

Throughout the primary and middle years, the school follows the British curriculum, with the vast majority of lessons being taught in English. Following the British model, students sit external exams in up to 10 subjects at the end of Year 11 (grade 10). For most subjects, the external examiner is Pearson Edexcel. For a small number, it is Cambridge International.

All our Year 12 and Year 13 students follow the IB curriculum, resulting in an IB Diploma or IB Course certificate. IB Diploma candidates select 3 subjects to study at Higher Level and 3 at Standard Level (6 in total). In addition, they study the IB DP core, which comprises: Theory of Knowledge (ToK), Extended Essay, and CAS (Creativity, Action and Service).

Group 1: English A: Language + Literature (HL / SL)

Group 2: French B (HL / SL) ; Spanish B (HL / SL) ; Spanish Ab Initio (SL)

Group 3: Geography (HL / SL) ; History (HL / SL)

Group 4: Biology (HL / SL) ; Chemistry (HL / SL) ; Physics (HL / SL) ; Computer Science (HL / SL) ; Sports, Exercise + Health Science (HL / SL)

Group 5: Mathematics: Analysis & Approaches (HL / SL) ; Mathematics: Applications & Interpretation (SL)

Group 6: Visual Arts (HL / SL)

Online Courses: Inspired King's InterHigh offer online courses in several additional subjects.

GRADING

Grading is dependent on the curriculum being followed. Grading in Years 12 and 13 is aligned with the IB grading of 1-7 (7 being the best). Grading in Years 10 and 11, however, is aligned with IGCSE being studied with Edexcel using a scale of 1-9 and Cambridge using a scale of A to G. We do not use the GPA scale nor do we rank students.



SCHEDULE

The school follows the international school calendar. The school year starts in August and runs until late June, divided in 3 terms.

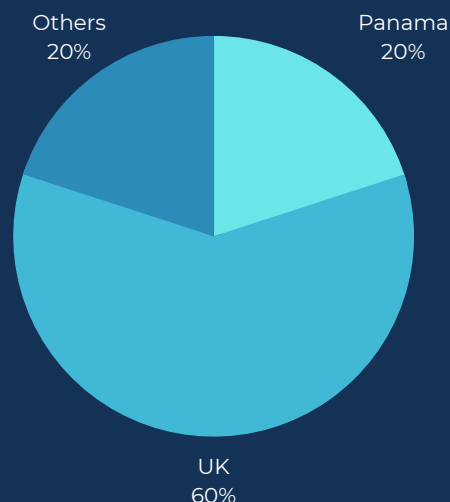
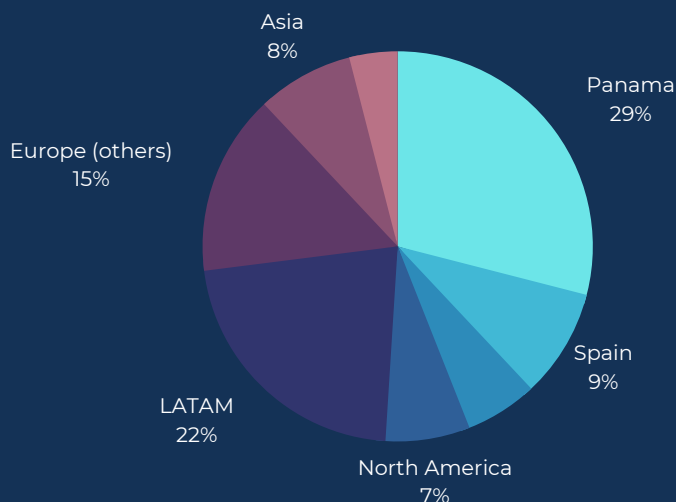
