In Key Stage 4 (Year 10 to 11), students begin CAIE International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE).



In Key Stage 5 (Year 12 to 13), students study for International A Levels leading to entry into the world's finest universities of their choice.


GRADING SYSTEM

The BVIS approach to student development is to place as much focus on what happens outside of the classroom as within it.


The school has an extensive programme of co-curricular activities, offering ample opportunity for sport, service and leadership, cultural, artistic and performance activities that students find personally enriching.


