
elcome to South Bank University Academy! Our motto "Create a better future" reflects our commitment to providing quality education to all students. We are a unique school, genuinely led by our values.



In addition to this, there are a large number of outside professionals who complement the work of the school staff offering expertise in their areas, such as Speech and Language Therapy and Occupational Therapy.

High quality teaching that is differentiated and personalised will meet the individual needs of our students. As part of this personalised teaching, there is a value placed on building a respectful and nurturing relationship between students and teachers to help with student progress and development.

We have an expert team of staff who are focused on quality teaching in the classroom. Where students need additional support, be it for special educational needs, disabilities, or additional English language support, we support them throughout their time in the Academy.

Our values-led approach ensures inclusivity for all students, irrespective of their background and this is reflected in our curriculum and enrichment programs, where we strive to support and empower students facing disadvantages, enabling them to attain academic success
