Many staff who work here moved here and decided to stay, a sure mark of how much they have enjoyed living and working in Bratislava.



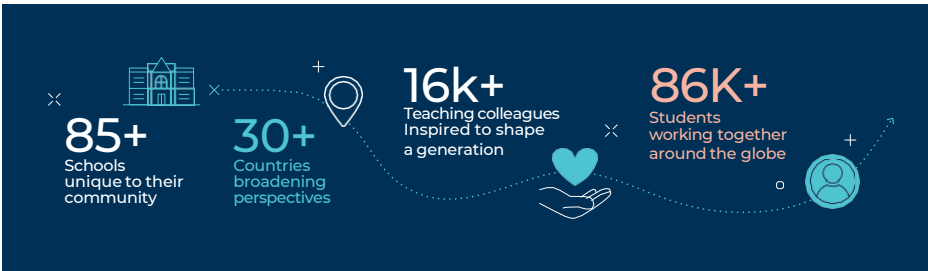
EXPLORING OUTSIDE BRATISLAVA

Travel options from Bratislava are superb. Vienna is less than 1 hour by car, train, bus or boat, Budapest is about 2 hours by train and Prague 4 hours by train. The Tatra mountains are around 3 hours away for various outdoor pursuits and rank as one of the most stunning mountain ranges in central Europe. If you like skiing, resorts can be reached in Slovakia or Austria in around 3 hours and if you prefer the beach, it is about 5 hours to the nearest Mediterranean coastline.

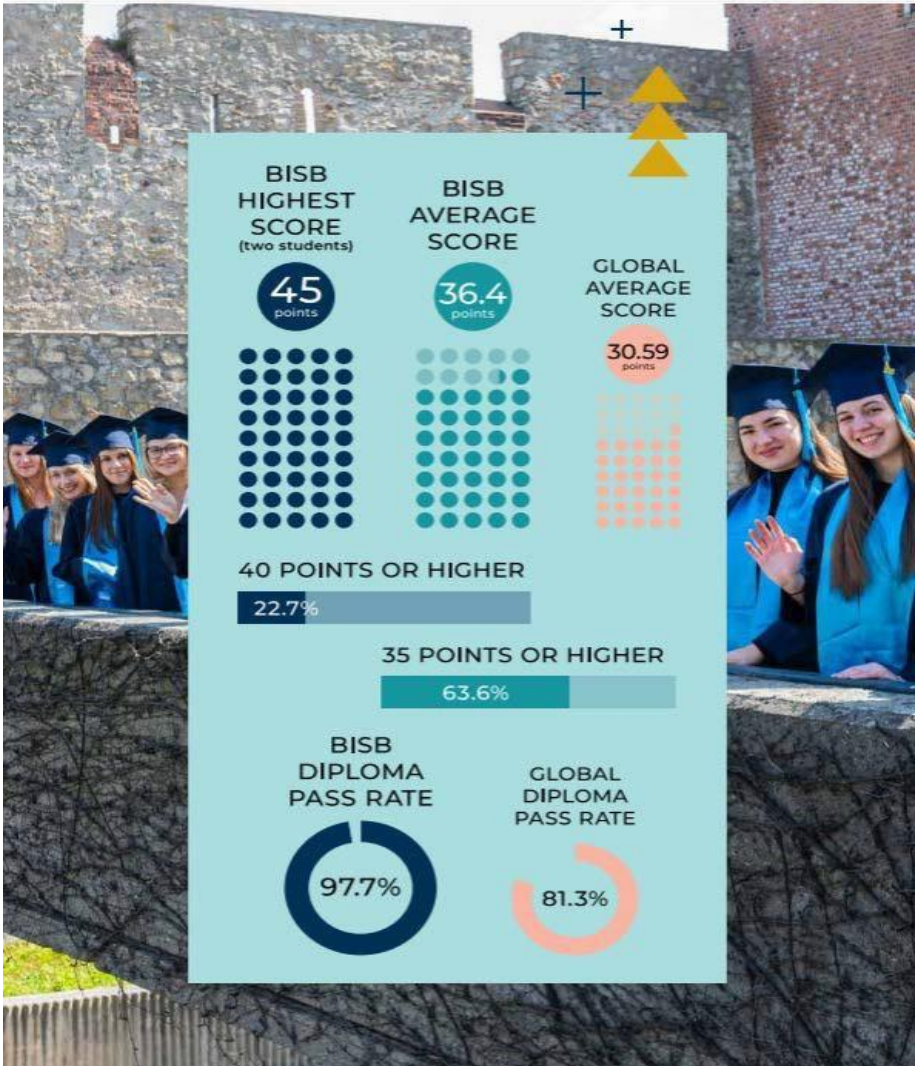
SCHOOL ACADEMIC RESULTS

The 2024-2025 school year was one of the strongest in terms of academic results.

For the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (Years 12 & 13), our students achieved a 36.3 Global point average, far exceeding the world average of 30.58. Two students achieved the maximum score of 45 points putting them in the worlds 1% and 63% of our students scored over 35 points.

In our IGCSE student cohort (Year 10 & 11), our students achieved an excellent set of results with 36 % of our grades being A*-A (against a UK average of 22%) and 87 % of our grades being A*-C (against a UK average of 67.5%)

We are immensely proud of the results that our students achieve.
