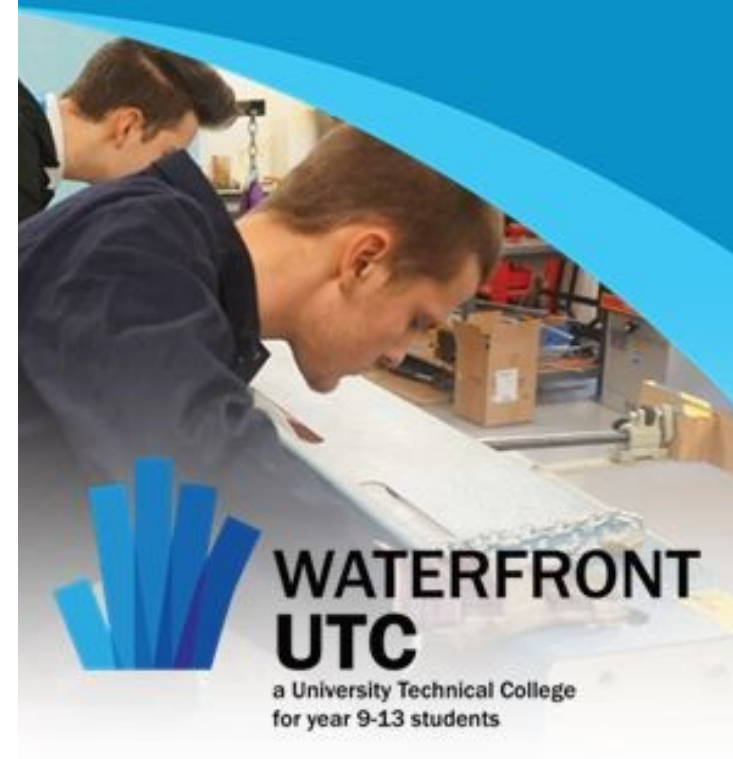

## Our Technical Specialisms

### Engineering

Waterfront UTC's engineering specialism enables students to gain a wide range of engineering skills and develop broad engineering technical knowledge. The UTC's students will gain from the expertise of engineering sponsors including BAE Systems, Delphi Diesel Systems and the Royal School of Military Engineering and they use the latest engineering technology to equip them to work effectively in this exciting and rapidly evolving sector. Students will develop their knowledge and skills within a broad engineering curriculum including product design and manufacture, mechanical, electrical and electronic engineering and computer aided design and manufacture. This will provide the platform for progression to a wide range of education, training and employment opportunities including further/higher education and apprenticeships.

### Construction and Built Environment

Through the Construction and Built Environment specialism students explore the specialist occupational roles involved in the sector as a whole such as civil engineering, architecture, design and surveying. The UTC will draw from the expertise of leading edge construction industry employers, including Bouygues UK, Redrow Homes and BAM Construct UK to design and deliver extensive, innovative and rich technical learning. There is a focus on green technologies and sustainable construction techniques and students learn about the relationship between construction, the built environment and wider society. There are opportunities to progress within further and higher education programmes, traineeships and apprenticeships, all supported by the close engagement of the University of Greenwich and MidKent College.

## Curriculum

Waterfront UTC offers the best of both worlds - students study in a work-like environment while still experiencing all the benefits that traditional schools offer. Our focused curriculum will prepare you for a career in engineering or construction sectors while keeping other career routes open.

### Key Stage 4:

Alongside the UTC's technical curriculum, students will study GCSEs which include:

Core subjects – English, Maths, Science

Option subjects – Design Technology: Product Design, Computer Science, Business Studies, History & Geography

### Key Stage 5:

Students who have successfully achieved a grade 4 or better in five or more GCSEs, including English and Maths, will be able to progress to Waterfront UTC's years 12 and 13 to follow a programme based on BTEC National (Level 3) qualifications in either Engineering or Construction & the Built Environment and/or A Levels.

Programmes of study for A Level standard courses are for students who have achieved at least five grade 5s in appropriate subjects.

A Level subjects on offer include: Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Business Studies, Product Design, Computer Science/Computing and English Lit
