Panyadee, the British School of Samui offers a full range of subjects to children from Foundation Stage 1 to Year 13 (3 years to 18 years).

Teachers at the school come from the United Kingdom, are qualified and have relevant teaching experience in Thailand.

The importance of the Thai language is not overlooked and Thai language and culture lessons are compulsory for all classes.



Facilities

The name PanyaDee is derived from the combination of two Thai words - literally translated *Panya* means **wisdom** and *Dee* means **good**. Since its opening in 2005 PanyaDee has evolved from a single classroom for eight students into a stunning educational facility with the main intention being to provide children with the best of education.

The school now boasts 11 classrooms plus a dedicated science room; a fully equipped music room, a new library; a networked computer room and three separate playground areas for different age groups. There's a five-a-side football pitch, basketball court, a covered canteen area and a fully operational kitchen where all school meals are prepared daily; school meals are included within the term fees.




School Curriculum

Tuition Fees

Nursery	53,500 Baht per term	(three term year)
Foundation Stage 1-2	53,500 Baht per term	(three term year)

*In Year 11, the half term is charged at 53,500B. This fee is charged due to the reduced time students are in class due to their participation in the IGCSE exams.

Term Payments

Students enrolled during the first half of any term will be subject to a full term's fee.

Students enrolled in the second half of any term will be subject to a lesser rate of: 42,800 Baht for foundation stage one to year six and 53,500 baht for year seven to year eleven.

Deposit

Due to limited class sizes and an increasing school population, Panyadee has decided to implement a student deposit scheme.

A 10,000 Baht deposit is required to register your child in a year group. The fee is applicable to each of the 3 terms and guarantees your child's place in the classroom for that term. **The 10,000 Baht deposit will be deducted from your term school fee when paid in full.**

For example: At the end of the term you enroll your child into year 4 and pay a 10,000 Baht deposit to ensure your place. When you come to pay your school fees for that term, the 10,000 Baht will be deducted from your overall fee. This is applicable to each term to ensure your child has a place in the classroom. We will accept new students during each holiday period; if you wish to guarantee your child's placement, we recommend paying before the end of term.

Any parents/guardians who do not wish to pay a deposit run the risk of not having a place for their child in the classroom.

New student registrations are required to pay for a full-term in advance before starting the school term.

All deposits are non-refundable.



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Fee Payment

Fees must be paid in the first two weeks of a new school term. If fees are not received by the due date, the student will not be admitted to the school for the term unless permission is granted by the Headmaster. Reports and certificates may be withheld if fees are not paid.

Discount

Panyadee offers a discounted price of 10% for a second child and 20% for a third (these discounts also apply to students enrolled in the 2nd half of any term). We also offer a discount of 10% for full payment of a school year's fees.

Method of Payment

All fees are billed and payable in Thai Baht.

Domestic payments may be made by cash, cheque or deposit/transfer directly to the school's account. International payments must be made by bank transfer or credit card to the school account.
