

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

OIC has earned a reputation as one of the top-performing A-level colleges in the UK since 2019. In 2023, we have once again secured our top position in the league tables in England despite notable changes in A-level grading nationwide. News reports indicate there has been a greater decline in top grades in England compared to other regions, with a difference of at least 7.5%. While England has experienced grade disinflation, Wales, Northern Ireland, and Scotland have implemented additional supportive measures since the pandemic. This has raised concerns about potential disparities in university placements due to the various grading approaches throughout the UK. However, the Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation (Ofqual) has assured that universities comprehend these differences.

A data-driven approach

Students are required to take short exams (SCITs) in each A-level subject on most Saturdays. These help students and teachers identify exact areas for improvement and prepare most effectively for exams through sufficient past paper practice.

Demonstrating your passion in the career you are pursuing is a parallel crucial element to academic excellence when applying to competitive courses at the world's top universities. At OIC, our Supercurricular department equips students for future success by deepening subject knowledge, engaging in diverse programmes, competitions, and awards, nurturing personal interests through clubs and societies, fostering a 'growth mindset' for personal development, offering university exploration support, and providing expert guidance throughout the university application process. This includes specialised Oxbridge mentoring and tailored pathways for students applying to overseas universities.





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YOUR HOME away from home



Boarding is at the heart of the OIC experience, where students live and study together, building a warm, international community. We aim to provide the perfect environment in which you can relax and study after an intense day of learning.

We offer four boarding options within the city of Oxford; each is purpose-built, spacious, en-suite accommodation with a bed, storage, and a study desk. The boarding package for all sites includes:
