
Cambridge International Examinations



The Kindergarten School curriculum is organised into 6 areas of learning:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Your child will learn to be self-confident, take an interest in things, know what their own needs and tell the difference between right and wrong.

Language and Literacy

Your child will learn to speak confidently and clearly. They will read and write some familiar words and learn to use a pencil. Your child will also have the opportunity to learn Lao Language and Chinese Language

Mathematical Development

Your child will develop an understanding of Maths through stories, songs, games and imaginative play. They will become comfortable with numbers and ideas such as "heavier than" or "bigger".

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Your child will explore and find out about the world around them, asking questions about it.

Physical Development

Your child will learn to move, controlling their body and handling equipment.

Creative Development

Your child will explore colours and shapes, trying out dance, making things, telling stories and making music.





The Primary School offers both an International as well as Lao programme:

The International Programme is for all primary class. The curriculum is developed under the framework of the British Education System and the International Primary Curriculum (IPC). The English National Curriculum develops essential skills in literacy, numeracy and scientific enquiry in students in the primary phase of their education, while IPC covers a solid knowledge base reflecting a global perspective, history, geography, social studies, health and values as well as creative development. The programme is an excellent preparation for the next phase in a student's learning, providing a foundation for secondary education, leading to the Cambridge certified checkpoints (Y7 - Y9) and International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) curriculum (Y10 - Y12).

The core subjects (English, Maths, and Science) are conducted in English by a diverse teaching certified staff. Additional classes are offered in ICT, Mandarin Chinese, Music, Arts & Crafts and Physical Education.

The <u>Lao Programme</u> is from Years 1 to 5. The core subjects are Language, Mathematics, Social Studies, as well as, Lao culture and ethics. The Lao Programme meets all requirements of the Lao Ministry of Education (MOE). At the end of the school year, the Year 5 sit for the exams given by the MOE and this qualifies the students to continue their education in secondary school Lao Programme.

The Secondary School also offers a bilingual curriculum:

The International Programme is from Year 7 to Year 12. The curriculum is designed to follow a course of study which provides a broad and balanced range of learning experiences. The Years 7 to 9 provide a strong foundation in English and academic skills necessary to succeed in the IGCSE curriculum. The Years 7 to 9 also follow the Cambridge Checkpoint Curriculum in the subjects of English, Maths, Science and ICT.

In Years 10 to 12, students begin to study Cambridge's IGCSE curriculum. The IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) is a 2+ year curriculum that follows detailed benchmarks that enable teachers and students to equally prepare for comprehensive exams identical to high school students from thousands of international and private schools around the globe.

Panyathip International School currently offers students the opportunity to study for international exams in the following subjects: English as a second language, Maths, Combined Science, ICT, Chinese as a foreign language, Environmental Management and Business Studies. P.I.S also offers non-academic courses in Sports and Arts.

The <u>Lao Programme</u> is from Years 6 to 12. The Lao Secondary Programme meets all requirements of the Lao Ministry of Education (MOE). Secondary students study Lao curriculums to become eligible for a Lao MOE high school diploma as well as eligibility to study at Lao university and other colleges in Vientiane and the whole Lao PDR.
