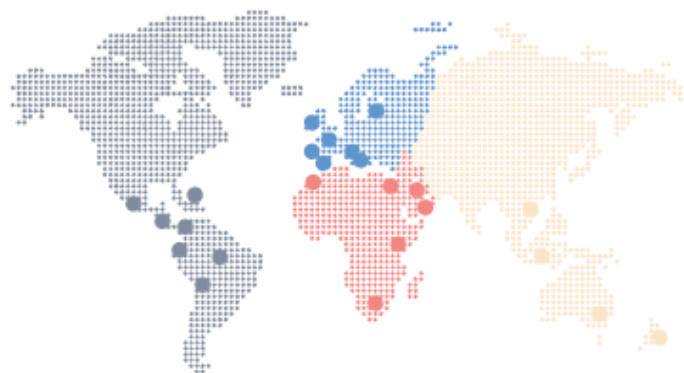

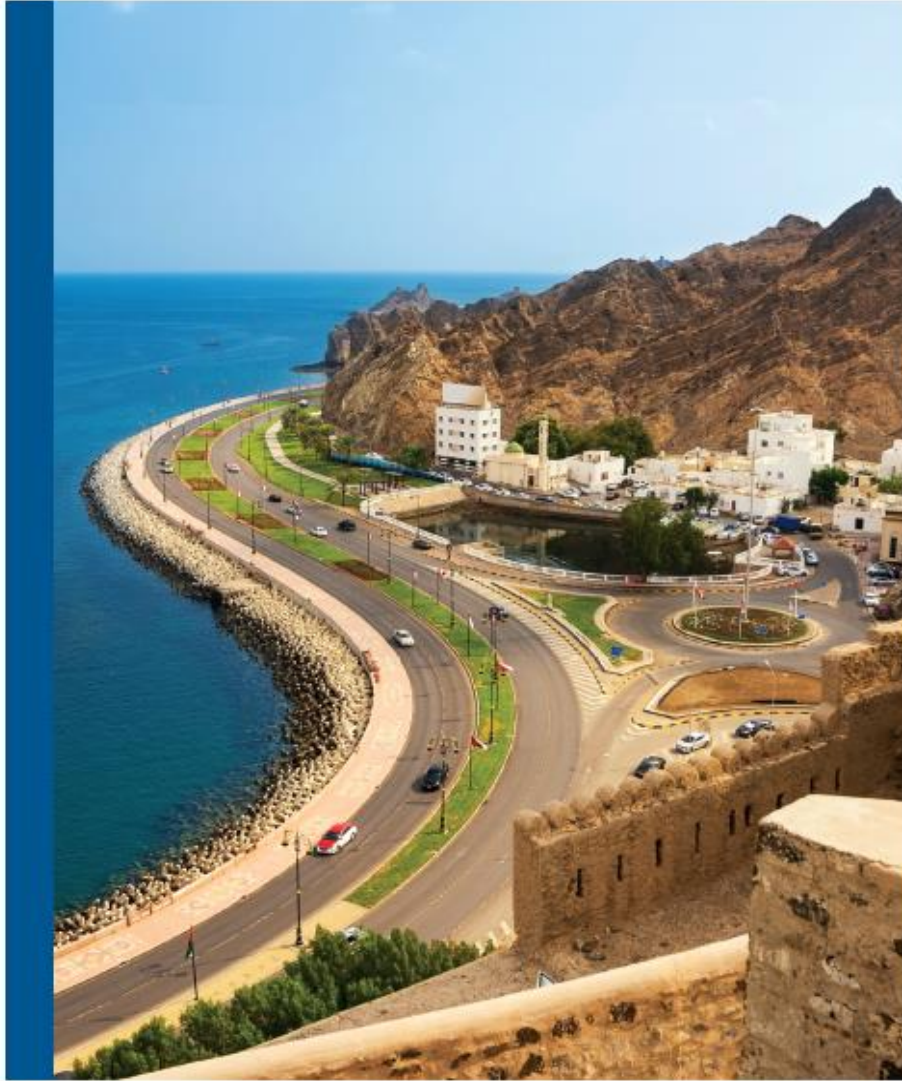
What do you like most about Knowledge Gate International School?
