We work with our families for a common goal; to help raise children who have the skills and knowledge as well as the characteristics they need to go out into the world as happy, safe and successful adults.

We are a non-selective school and our admissions policy prioritises students who are looked after; those with an education health care plan, then those with siblings already attending the school and those with a parent working at the school. 
