Pre Prep (3-7 years)

For children at the very start of their school life, AGS offers well planned activities in spacious and stimulating classrooms, all supported by well equipped outdoor learning areas.

Our youngest pupils are encouraged to use their creativity and imagination to learn about the world and their surroundings through a balance of play and structured activities. By learning to interact with others, look, listen and investigate, these young pupils are introduced to the routine and discipline of a school day providing them with the necessary skills ready for progression into Reception class.

Storytelling, role play, creative and investigative activities all help and develop enquiring minds. As their knowledge and confidence grows pupils are encouraged and rewarded to work to the best of their abilities and to take pride in their achievements.

Our child centered approach and, broad topic based curriculum help children learn through first hand experience both inside and outside the classroom. With the focus on key Literacy and numeracy skills teaching is built around topics and related activities through the introduction of subjects such as science and humanities. Studies in Arabic Language, Social Studies and Islamic religion are offered to our pupils at this stage. Children develop their abilities through writing, ICT, art and teamwork projects. This creative approach to learning helps to capture a child's natural curiosity while expanding their knowledge and understanding.

At AGS we are equipped to support and encourage individual development through extra tuition if required during this vital time in a child's learning ready for the move to the Lower Prep department.

Lower Prep (7-10 years)

In Lower Prep there is a strong focus on academic excellence and high moral standards. Pupil progress is carefully monitored by class teacher ongoing assessment and end of term tests. Children are recognized for their achievements in all areas of school life through praise and reward by all AGS staff. AGS pupils are expected to demonstrate independence and commitment to their studies by completing work to the very best of their abilities both in school and at home.

We expect our pupils to be polite, respectful and helpful to all throughout the school day and in the wider community.




Upper Prep (10-13 years)

We strive to maximize each child's potential through a continued focus on academic excellence in order to deliver results that match abilities. We actively encourage positive competition, responsibility and ownership of a child's overall development by having the chance to become a member of the school council, be a Prefect, Head of Line, Head Boy or Head Girl.

Children are encouraged to make the very most of their talents and strengths but also aim to improve in subject areas that may require more focus and time through extra teacher support and advice. All pupils are well prepared for the adaption and expectations of the Senior school by the end of Upper Prep.





Senior School (13-18 years)

Students in the Senior School experience a new level of independence. Working towards their IGCSE and A-Level studies, all students are expected to take responsibility for their own learning. A strong emphasis on academic rigour and extended learning opportunities, ensure that students are ready for the challenge of University and beyond.

Independent study opportunities allow students to develop the skills for University and organizing their own time, managing deadlines and using different mediums to present their work are all essential skills. 
