DSB is a small, friendly school where we aim to maximise every student's potential. Class sizes are small, averaging under 15 students. This allows for personalised learning. We are the only school in Mumbai to offer the National Curriculum of England. We are proud of our German heritage and maintain strong links with German organisations and schools.

The language of instruction at DSB is primarily English but, uniquely at our school, all students study German as a second language from kindergarten upwards, and aim to become competent users of the language. Our graduates have the linguistic ability to apply to study at German universities.

Our diverse student population comes from some 25 countries across every inhabited continent on the planet. The perspectives of our staff members from around the world are at the heart of our identity as an international school. We strive to make our students the change-makers of the future.

At DSB, we offer both the National Curriculum of England and the German curriculum of Thuringia for students up to Grade 8 - between the ages of 3 to 14. We also offer the Cambridge IGCSE programme in Grades 9 and 10, as well as the IB Diploma Programme in Grades 11 and 12.

IB subjects (Grades 11 and 12)

We offer a choice of 15 subjects across six groups: Studies in Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Experimental Sciences, Mathematics, and The Arts.

IGCSE subjects (Grade 9 and 10)

We offer a choice of 18 subjects across five groups: Languages, Humanities and Social Sciences, Sciences, Mathematics, and Creative and Professional.

IB results

While we are not a selective school, our school average (32.2) has remained comfortably above the world average (30.2) over the 2017 to 2020 period.

IGCSE results

An impressive 80% of our students received at least five A* - C results over the 2017 to 2020 period.

International experience

Our students come from around 25 countries around the world, contributing to a uniquely multicultural environment. Our teachers also come from a wide range of different countries including the Czech Republic, Egypt, France, Germany, Russia, South Africa, the United Kingdom, the United States of America, and of course all over India.

Cross-curricular weeks:

These happen twice a term. The timetable is collapsed and students work on a critical thinking project in teams across age groups. For example:

- Designing a sustainable city, including constructing a 3D building to scale and research into sustainable urban planning
- Designing a city tour, including costing, transport, maps, and marketing
