


Success and achievement for all

Together our schools provide a full range of academic and vocational education to re-engage pupils, and to provide the support that mainstream schools and families need to give every child the best chance of success. Our schools cater for children with any combination of circumstances and requirements.

Based on the historic Swindon Street site, **Coal Clough Academy** is a well-established alternative provision school for children aged 11 - 16, rated Good by Ofsted at its inspection in June 2018.

Coal Clough typically provides longer term placements for children with multiple additional needs, working to re-engage them within education, creating education healthcare plans to support SEND needs and to ensure that development continues through to further education and adulthood.

Pupils are taught in small groups, where they study the core curriculum and can receive the extra support they require. Staff ensure that learning is tailored to individual student needs, and we provide rich and varied curriculum opportunities ranging from vocational courses, academic programmes and programmes that support pupils' personal and social development.

At Key Stage 3, our focus is on supporting young people to return to a mainstream school. At Key Stage 4, our aim is for students to gain good academic attainment on par with mainstream schools, to ensure a successful transition to college, training or employment. This includes work experience opportunities for Key Stage 4 pupils, and summer school for one week during the summer holidays.

Coal Clough Academy also delivers outreach work including CPD and support sessions for our colleagues in mainstream education.

The Heights Burnley



The Heights Burnley is an Alternative Provision School for pupils aged 5 to 16. The modern campus was purpose-built in 2019 following the demand from local head teachers. The school offers state of the art facilities with an abundance of outdoor space including our own forest school area.

The curriculum delivers a mix of vocational studies, learning outside of the classroom, personal and social development programmes, as well as the core curriculum - designed to focus on early intervention and short to medium-term stays, with the aim of reengaging pupils and preparing them for a successful return to mainstream education.

Our Nurture provision offers a focussed, short-term intervention strategy for KS1, 2 and 3 pupils. The provision benefits from small class sizes, enabling intense input from the staff and provides a safe and structured environment in which pupils are given opportunities to develop emotionally and socially.

Our curriculum at KS4 is both broad and balanced, providing students with the right courses and guidance to enable them to take the next step in their education and careers. In addition to studying qualifications in maths, English and science we also have bespoke and contemporary facilities to offer a range of high quality vocational qualifications
