Why Poltair School?

Poltair has been through a rapid, transformational journey since joining the Cornwall Education Learning Trust. We now offer a truly unique and exemplary provision for families in the St. Austell area.

Poltair is a school where so much is happening. We're currently undertaking a considerable refurbishment in order to upgrade the learning environments and facilities available to our students. Our new Library area opened this September, placing a wonderful collection of books at the heart of school; to reflect the importance reading has within the Poltair experience. Alongside the Library, we now benefit from a new Reception and The Arc and Arc 2 - our two new large IT suites. Work is underway to reconfigure and refurbish the Art & DT block, to create a suite of state-of-the-art learning spaces for Art, DT, Catering, Music, Drama and Vocational Studies.

Alongside these substantial upgrades to the Poltair buildings and facilities, we have also introduced some exciting and pioneering changes to our teaching & learning offer. The school saw its best GCSE results in history this summer and with the development of both curriculum delivery and enrichment experiences, there really couldn't be a better time to be considering Poltair School.

Student Experience

A child's experience in school is more than just what is taught. We have designed our curriculum to provide opportunities for creativity and success, whilst ensuring that students are adequately challenged. Teaching & Learning

Reading

We are incredibly proud to have implemented a thriving reading programme on a grand scale. The energy and commitment invested by each member of staff has, and will, continue to reap huge gains, both on an academic and a pastoral level.

- 5. On-going improvement in independent reading skills




Enrichment

Support

Special Educational Needs:

Some students require additional support to ensure they are able to reach their full potential. For some, this may be an identified learning need, for others it might be a social or emotional need. Whether students require short or long term support, the interventions are tailored to the individual needs of the student.

Pastoral Support:

Our pastoral system is designed to ensure that every child gets the support and challenge they need, when they need it. Meeting the needs of the children is paramount to their success. Sometimes, the support may be about ensuring they try their best - our behaviour system is very clear, to ensure that every child works to maintain the calm and focussed learning environment we have. Sometimes it may be support in confidence or other areas that is needed. Whatever it is, the pastoral system is there for them, to make sure their experience of school is positive and they feel safe.

Before your child even gets to Poltair, our transition team will be working with their primary school, to make sure they are known before they even set foot in the building.











Transition

Selecting a Secondary School, and then making the move from Primary to Secondary, can be a daunting process for many children and their parents/ quardians. That's why we feel it's really important to help Year 6 students be as prepared as possible for the move. At Poltair, we hold several welcome events throughout the school year. There are two 'Welcome Afternoons' (for parents and students) and two induction days where the young people will spend time in their new tutor groups and school setting before the summer holiday and their start in the September. We produce a welcome pack for the students and their parents, as well as online content, to answer any questions and address any concerns. The term starts with a Year 7 Induction Day, focused on helping the students build new friendships and learn their way around, followed by an Activity Day.

Results

We are exceptionally proud of the hard work and dedication our Year 11 students showed last year. Despite the turmoil and disruption of the Covid pandemic, they rose to the challenge of the first proper GCSE examinations in three years, with maturity and confidence, achieving the best GCSE results in our school's history! Students made significantly better progress across all measures.

Our Class of 22 have shown huge confidence and character by rising to every challenge given to them and achieving incredible individual results. We are immensely proud of their achievements and the tireless work of colleagues. This set of results evidences the enormous improvements that have been made at the school.


