

INDEPENDENT LEARNING PROJECTS

The ILP begins in Year 10 where students explore the principles of design thinking and engage in real-world challenges. Year 11 expands students' horizons, delving into philosophical viewpoints and developing analytical thinking and research skills. In Year 12 students choose their ILP pathway, opting for the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) or the Community Connection pathway. The EPQ allows students to develop project management skills and complete an individual project, while the Community Connection pathway applies design thinking to address real-world issues. Year 13 focuses on students making a demonstrable impact on the community through individually managed projects.

Throughout the ILP, students' progress is assessed based on key competencies for the future, such as critical thinking, analysis, metacognition, creativity, leadership, and collaboration. The ILP prepares students for higher education and the evolving demands of the professional world. 

Design Technology Workshop



Catering

Breakfast and dinner are included in our meal plan, provided seven days a week. The menu, developed in conjunction with external caterers, ensures a healthy and balanced diet that respects the cultural and religious requirements of our students.

During the school week, students can enjoy lunch at one of the many affordable, yet high-quality food and beverage outlets in the Hartamas Shopping Mall and surrounding precinct. Weekend lunches will depend on the activities students partake in and could be within the boarding house or off-site.

Co-Curricular Activities

All boarders are encouraged to participate in the co-curricular activity programme provided by the school. Additionally, we organise regular activities and excursions during the weekends. Our boarders take the lead in organising these activities, similar to our school clubs and societies. Community outreach forms a key part of our programme, with all boarders expected to dedicate some time to making a difference within our community.

Transportation

Boarders travelling independently receive a welcome and departure service at all KL Airports and the KL Sentral train station. This service includes a friendly greeting by a Charterhouse staff member, assistance with check-in at the airport or train station, and transport to and from the boarding house. Furthermore, Charterhouse Malaysia offers daily transportation to and from school.
