

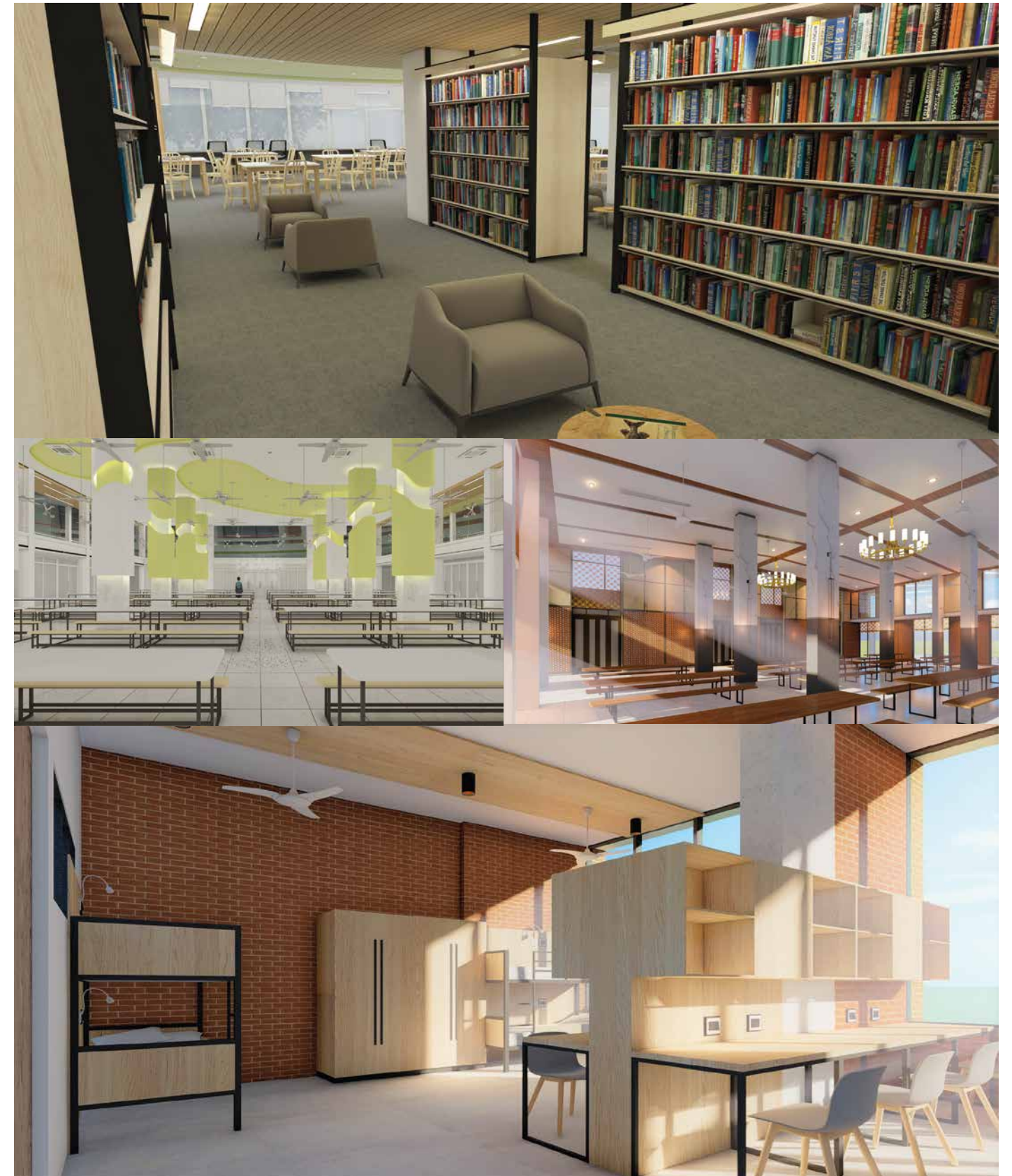

## Learning Support

We understand that students learn at different rates and may require additional support in order to access curriculum. It is our priority to ensure that each Haileyburian is known and provided with every opportunity to achieve, which is why we have established a Learning Support Department.

Our specialist teachers will provide assessments and one-on-one support in a quiet environment for students across all years. Our Learning Support Department is also available to help students overcome any English language difficulties.

As always, our Learning Support team operates with the utmost of care and discretion, while partnering closely with parents to communicate individualized support plans.

## Years 7 to 9 (ages 11 to 14)

Our youngest students are at an important stage in academic and social development. Years 7 to 9 transition into senior school students who experience significant changes to the timetable, curriculum and teachers. Our broad timetable focuses on developing successful values and positive attitudes to support our students through the year groups.

## Years 10 to 11 (ages 14 to 16)

This is a key stage of learning, where students are working towards their The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSEs). Bangladeshi students are also expected to sit Bengali and Bangladesh studies to help them to appreciate the language and culture and prepare them for the future as global citizens.



## The Sixth Form (Years 12 to 13, ages 17 & 18)

There is a caring atmosphere at Haileybury in the Sixth Form, each student being given personal attention supporting their university applications. We have experts who guide them to deciding which university and areas of study are the best fit.

Our school is currently working towards accreditation in the IB Diploma Programme for our Sixth Form (Years 12 & 13).





# University Preparation

Haileybury Bhaluka leverages its international network of trustees, alumni and consultants in supporting students to gain entry to the world's most competitive universities such as: Oxford, Cambridge, London School of Economics, Harvard, Princeton, Yale, Stanford, McGill and University of Toronto to name a few.

Pupils who are applying to universities in any country have access to specialised advice and counselling so that they make the best possible choices.

Haileybury Bhaluka ensures that every pupil has the opportunity to take advantage of all the support they need when it comes to testing, essay writing, financial aid applications and interviews which also includes support for specialised university entrance examinations (for example to Oxford and Cambridge).





# Committed to Care

We take our responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of your children seriously.

Each house is led by a Housemaster or Housemistress (HM) who become the key people in the life of your son. Each house has a highly experienced team which also includes two Assistant Housemasters (AHM) and a matron who assists in the smooth running of the house, including laundry, medical issues and offering pastoral support. The Assistant Housemasters will be on duty when the HM is not in the house and they are jointly responsible for the students. In addition to this, all academic staff are attached to the houses as part of the academic and pastoral team and they are on duty at various times during the week to provide academic and pastoral support to the students. They are often on duty and available for one to one support when required.

## Boarding Life

We understand that the decision to send the child to boarding school is one of mixed emotions for many families. Rest assured that at Haileybury Bhaluka, our boarding experience is an opportunity for your son to develop a deeper sense of character, engage in new experiences, make life-long connections and gain invaluable independence.

Our boarders live amongst their peers in a warm, friendly community, where reflective practitioners enhance learning and help students thrive. Student well-being is of the utmost importance to us. Our boarding programme ensures our students will have a strong relationship with their Head of House and Residential Team, who will become their second family in their home away from home. Our boarding houses are more than just residences; they make up the heart of our community, where lasting memories and friendships are made.

## Boarding Programme

Our residential House system in Haileybury Bhaluka is based on the traditional boarding house programme at Haileybury in the UK. It is the centre of the life of the school. Our pupils benefit from the help of a dedicated House Master or House Mistress, and two additional assistants House Masters/Mistresses. Each house has a Matron who makes sure that the house is run efficiently.





## Health and Wellbeing

Our community benefits from a dedicated health and wellbeing centre staffed by full time doctors, nurses and psychotherapists. Students will have around-the-clock access to care, extending from medical to mental health services. The centre is open every day of the week by appointment with our medical team.

Wellbeing matters at Haileybury Bhaluka and pupils are provided with a safe space to express their feelings. The wellbeing centre is a supervised facility where students can retreat and relax away from the busy activities and lessons. Our garden, in particular, is an oasis where students can experience the intrinsic benefits of growing and nurturing plants and vegetables.

## Spiritual Life

Haileybury Bhaluka is an inclusive setting where students of all faiths and beliefs are welcome. We encourage our pupils to socialise and celebrate diversity, whilst practicing deeply personal spiritual introspection and prayer. We promote a spiritual and values-based education that is tolerant of all religions.

## Activities

Being a pupil at Haileybury Bhaluka is much more than a narrow academic experience. Education of the “whole child” is at the heart of our values. The essential purpose of the co-curricular programme in our school is to holistically generate and develop his interests, engagements, passions, and skills well beyond the academic curriculum.

Ranging from music and sport alongside Model UN, public speaking, and debate. We offer a wide range of organised co-curricular activities designed for our pupils to discover and experience new possibilities in the safe and disciplined environment of our peaceful residential campus.

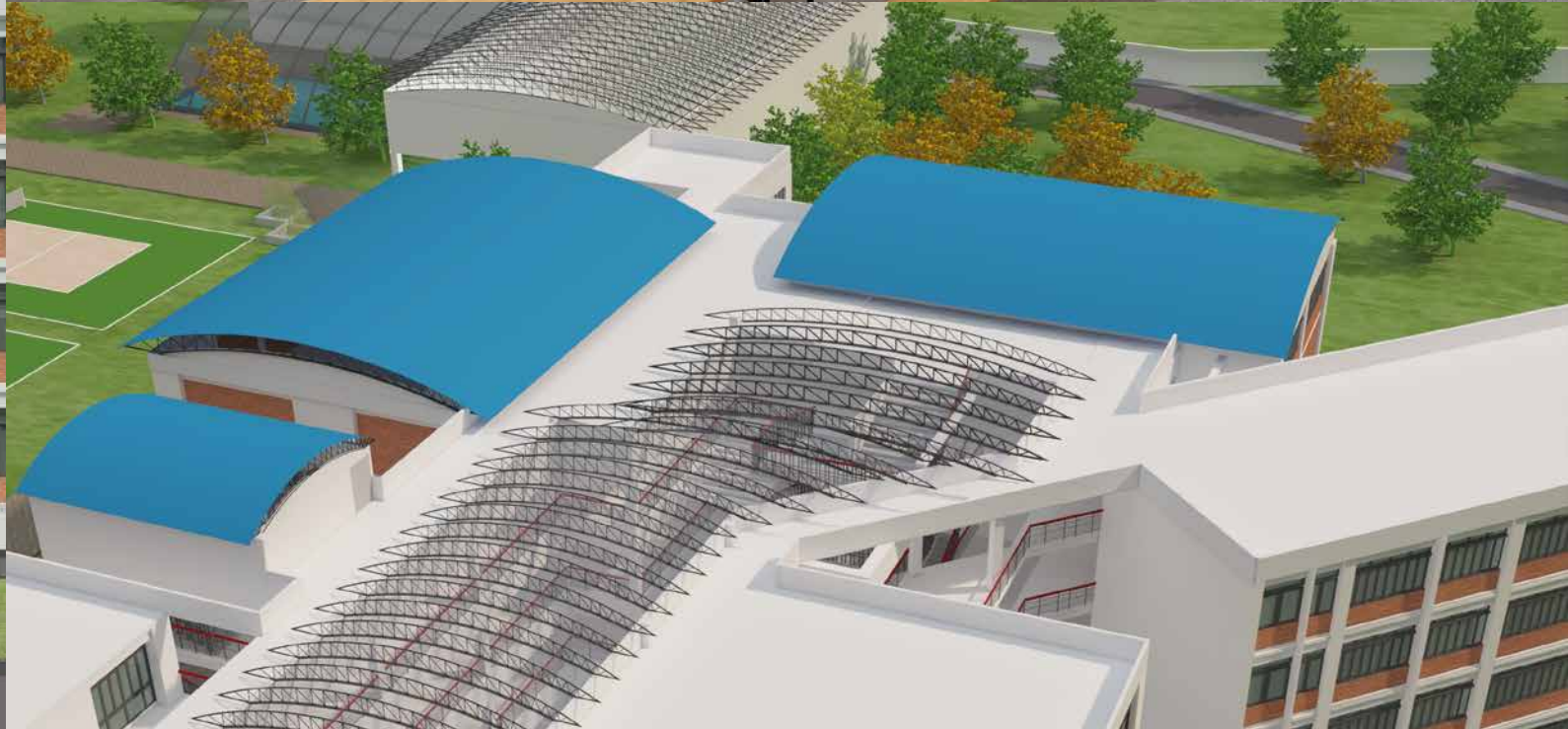
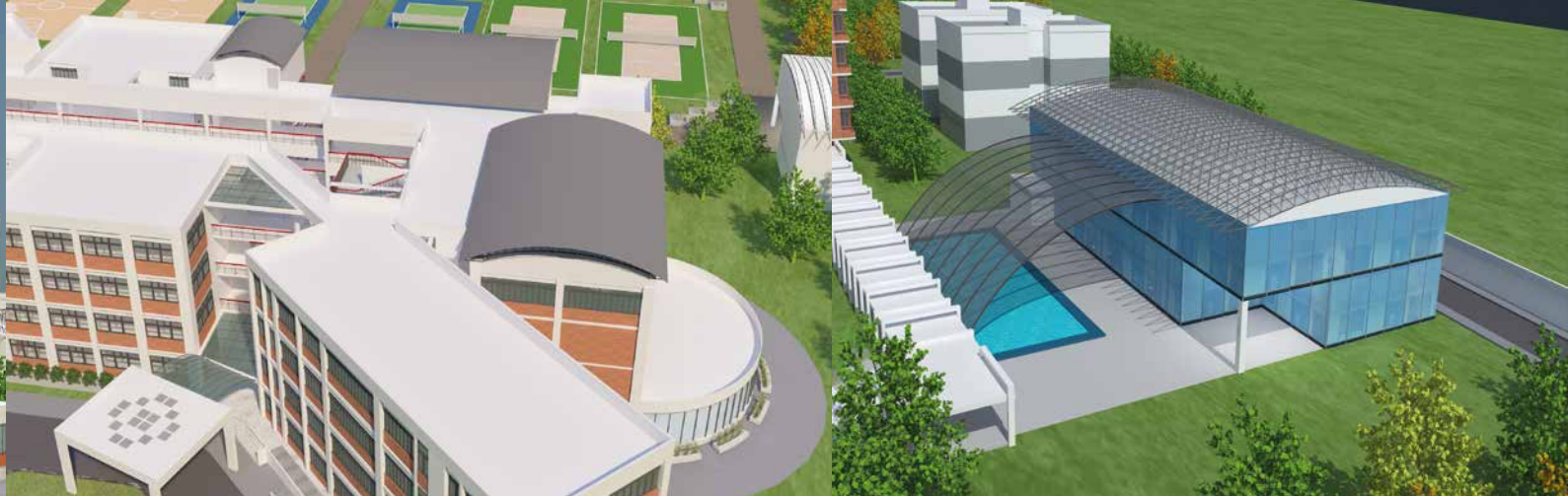


## Haileybury Community
