The school is 42,000 square metres and is home to a range of well-resourced specialist teaching facilities such as laboratories, drama studios, and music facilities to support the delivery of a personalised, flexible and relevant curriculum.

PHASES OF THE SCHOOL

Early Learning School (EL1 to Reception) - 3 months to 4 years

Families with younger children are catered for through our Early Learning School with purpose-built facilities and expert staff. Our ELS is influenced by the Reggio Emilia approach, which believes as a central tenant, that children are confident and capable learners from birth, the school's ELS curriculum follows the Inspired approach to Early Learning where children learn through play alongside specialist teaching in literacy and numeracy.

Primary School (Year 1 to Year 6)

The Primary School is a vibrant, lively community, with a broad curriculum where children are given space, countless opportunities and support to grow in confidence and discover their individual talents. A supportive teaching and learning environment, and a commitment to academic, creative, cultural and sporting excellence will enable a momentum to succeed.

Form Tutors are supported by subject specialist teachers and support staff who, together, bring a wealth of experience and diverse talents to the Primary School. Developing confidence is also a central importance to the community and children will be encouraged to explore and represent the core values of the school.

Senior School (Year 7 to Year 13) – 12 to 18 years


The Senior School provides a dynamic, flexible curriculum with a rigorous academic, creative and sporting education which aims to challenge and engage, offering a secure foundation on which to continue into higher education and beyond. Students will progress through international GCSE and A level or IB Diploma programmes. The wider curriculum develop lifelong skills in building and maintaining relationships; leadership skills; oratory and presentation competencies; and preparation for independence in adult life. This vital approach values these developing competencies in young people, as well as the mental health and wellbeing of each student.

University Admissions

Helping students navigate the most appropriate pathway for their aims and aspirations is a key part of the Sixth Form. Every student will receive university counselling to prepare them for any of the top universities around the world. Specialist staff and the School Principal work closely with the students, creating a strong record of successful entry to leading universities around the world.






JOIN US
