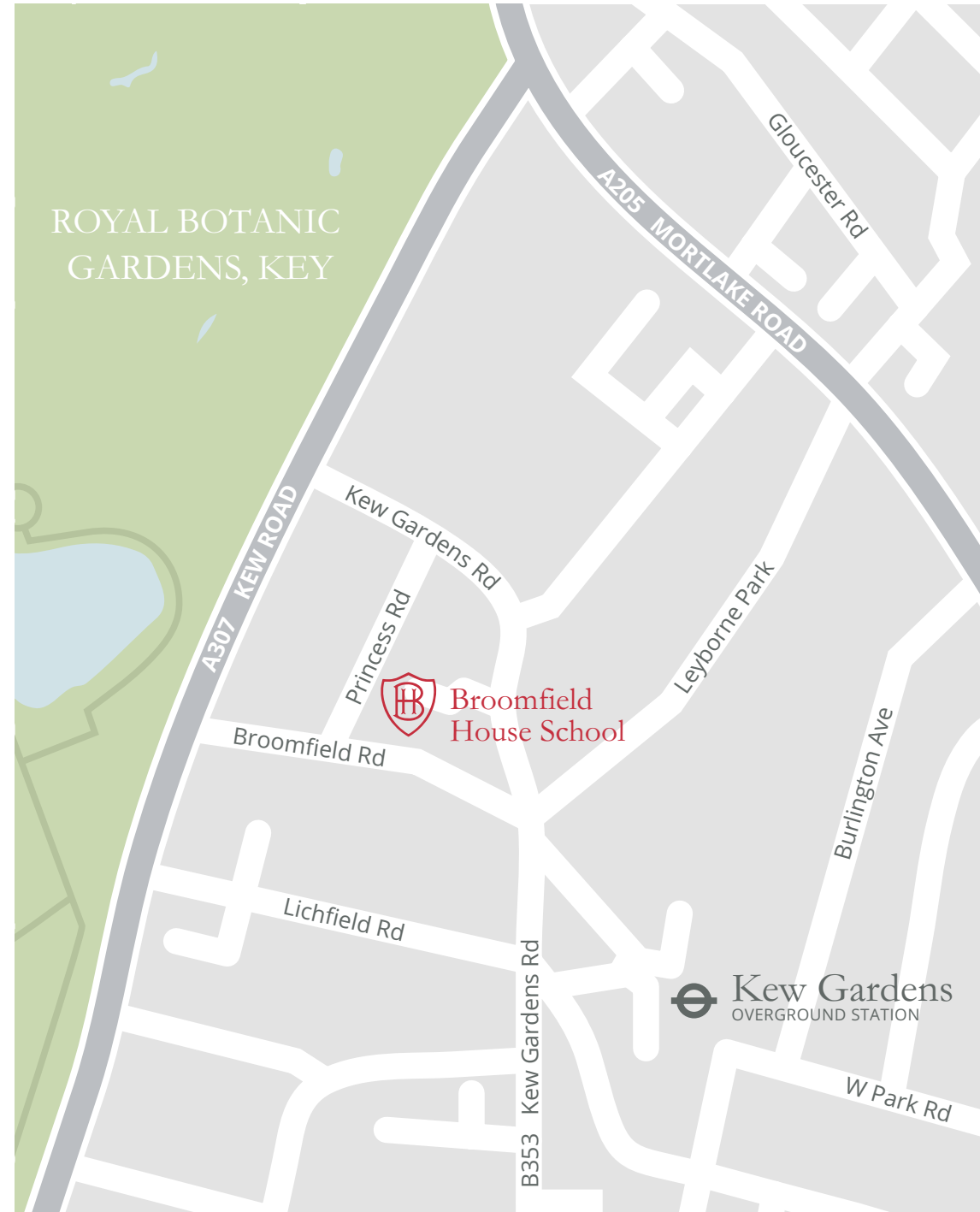
ABOUT
