Students and staff are thrilled with Heber's GCSE results in 2017!

Students, staff and parents at Bishop Heber High School celebrated their success in 2017. Almost 73% of Year 11 students at Bishop Heber High School achieved the national benchmark of five or more GCSE passes at A*-C including the new 9-4 grades in English and Mathematics (80% inc legacy A*-C grades). An outstanding achievement! A superb 83% achieved grades 9-4 in English, and 79% achieved grades 9-4 in the new Mathematics GCSE. Subjects in which students achieved more than 40% A*/A grades include Art, Biology, Chemistry, DT Textiles, IT, Physics and Religious Studies. Students from across the ability range have achieved results that are a credit to them and demonstrate superb progress. In many cases they have exceeded their predicted grades in all subjects. In addition to their GCSE successes, Year 11 students also made valuable contributions to the School and wider community in many other ways, including raising money for charity and as Volunteer Sports Leaders and Peer Mentors. Many have also completed the Duke of Edinburgh's Award in their own time demonstrating their commitment to their personal progress.
