Thank you for your interest in the post of Design & Technology teacher. We are a friendly and supportive department and would be excited to welcome forward-thinking, hardworking and passionate teachers to the team.

The successful applicant will be able to teach KS3 Design & technology, GCSE Design & technology and/or Level 2 Engineering. The ability to teach A Level Product Design is an advantage.

This position is suitable for either a newly qualified or more experienced teacher and has a start date of Easter 2019. Kennet has an excellent CPD programme and works closely with teachers at all stages of their careers to support their professional development and progression.

Design & Technology is a popular subject at GCSE with pupils of all abilities and currently has six classes in Year 11 and three in Year 10. A level Product Design has a strong cohort of 18 pupils who have applied for next academic year.


The broad and diverse content of Design & Technology is currently delivered by a dedicated team of eight well-qualified and experienced teachers, ably supported by three technicians and a specialist teaching assistant. D&T is taught to all pupils between the ages of 11 to 14 on a rotation with Food preparation & nutrition and then pupils may opt in Year 10 for one of our KS4 courses.

The D&T department currently occupies six rooms within the Faculty. Two are designated workshops with a shared heat treatment room, two textiles workrooms, one design studio and one CAD/CAM suite. Rooms are serviced by a full-time technician and two part-time technicians and are very well resourced for equipment including laser cutters and 3D printers. The Faculty also has priority Use of an ICT room. The D&T department currently offer community workshops, workshops for AG&T pupils, masterclasses for Y5 pupils and have a good participation rate in local and national competitions such as AWE challenges and the Big Bang competition. We organise trips to the Sustainability centre, Design museum, Mini plant & local print works to enrich pupils' experience of D&T.
