Entering our 4th Year in 2022, we are now at 1200 girls ranging from EYFS1 to Year 13. Following the British Curriculum and the MOE regulations for Arabic studies, our girls develop into confident, independent women. We are a school where our school values and Qatari values underpin all we do. Girls develop from DSGD to University with students being offered places in universities such as Carnegie Mellon and Northwestern. All Staff joining our team need to ready for the challenge of our unique school. In 2023/24 we will be entering our 5th Year and will be offering girls a first-class education from EYFS1 to Year 13. You will be joining an amazing school family and community, unlike no other. We are the first British Girls School, but also the only ALL female Campus. Like Durham UK, the staff will help to create a warm and secure learning environment where dedicated staff support and develop the girls in our care. At Durham School for Girls, we aim to really support staff in this transition of being away from home and starting a new life abroad. This is a challenging time for all teachers, and we want to ensure that our staff are ready for their life in Doha. All members of the Durham Community form the Durham Family.

Leadership is challenging and we want to ensure that as leaders, we are supported, respected, and listened to. There are 3 Vice Principals in the School – Arabic, Primary and Secondary. Each VP runs their own leadership team and is responsible for the daily logistics of these sections in the school. Collectively with the Principle the Senior SLT is formed. A VP is responsible for their section, but also must have whole school vision and understanding.

Being part of the senior Leadership team is a key opportunity to shape the development of the school. We have built the foundations and now it is time to take the school to the next level. As a Senior Leader, this is chance to be instrumental as we move into a more strategic period.

Built around our MARK Values, we are working on the 3 main principles.

Attendance Raising standards to over 90% attendance for all pupils.

Attainment With our first cohorts coming through the school we want to set and achieve ambitious targets for our girls to be competitive in their careers.

Attitude Values, Reputation and Sisterhood underpin all we do.

The school puts a lot of emphasis on being the best we can be. This is for staff and students alike. Welfare, especially during this time is super important. We have strong programmes to support the staff and the school has a welfare team that arranges events and support for everyone. Living in the school residence ensures that people are never alone, but having individual apartments gives staff the independence to create a home/school balance. At Durham we want to continue to adapt to provide the best learning for our girls and develop new skills in our teachers. Staff joining the school need to be flexible and adaptable to change their delivery but still ensure we are giving our girls the best learning experience despite the current situation. As a leader, we are looking for vision, resilience, empathy, a sense of humour and the understanding of the challenges in international teaching at this time.

As a woman moving to the Middle East, you want to be sure that it is a country you can live and work in easily. Doha is a very easy country to adapt to. It is an amazing place and very safe. It has been regularly voted one of the safest countries in the world.

Qataris are open, hospitable, and proud people. They are family orientated and welcome visitors to their country.

The lifestyle of living in Qatar is very high and relatively easy. As a country, there are restrictions regarding alcohol, unmarried relationships, and dress code, but these are similar to the rest of the region.

The country is thriving and hotels, shops etc are open. With events such as the FIFA World Cup, Formula 1, Qatar Expo, Qatar is making an impact on both the regional stage and worldwide.

It is a city of contrasts of heritage and tradition against modern and invitation. Over the next couple of years there will be a lot of building and development as the metro system is installed throughout the city. There is a lot of construction in preparation for the World cup, but all of this enhances the city and its facilities. Our staff and students took part in the Arab Cup as FIFA flag bearers and there are amazing volunteer programs to be part of.

Dress code – Respectful – In public places, knees and shoulders must be covered. Women do not have to cover their heads, other than by choice in public. In International hotels and private beaches, women can wear normal swim wear and shorts. In school we have a strong dress code

Alcohol – Westerners can purchase alcohol in specific places, and it can be consumed in their homes. In all the main international hotels alcohol can be bought in all the bars and restaurants.

Shopping – Qatar is the land of the Malls. It is any shopper's paradise. Prices are reasonably inline with Europe and the US. Shops include all major Highstreet retailers. Topshop, H&M, M&S, Gap, IKEA....

Things to do – There is always so much going on in the city and around, amazing beaches and incredible sporting facilities, music and art festivals and international events. World Championships for swimming, gymnastics, and tennis, Formula 1, Asian Games, Amazing Museums and concerts and events. Doha is a major international hub and access to India, Turkey, Jordan, Oman is a short distance away. Returning to the UK is 6-7 hours direct.
